

COVID Guidelines

as of 01/14/2022

- Daycare (zero tolerance for any symptoms- must be tested or stay home)
 - No quarantine required if:
 - Had COVID in last 90 days;
 - Vaccinated and/or boosted
 - If child or staff member tests +:
 - Out for 10 calendar days;
 - Day 0= 1st day of symptoms;
 - Quarantine anyone w/close contact to +
 - 10 days
 - Release from health department w/date
 - If + within staff or child's home:
 - Quarantine likely start after + person is released;
 - Likely 10 additional days
- K-12 students/staff
 - Close contact (within 6 ft for total of 15 min. or more over 24-hr period)
 - Quarantine for 5 days;
 - Can attend school if antigen tested during 5 day period
 - Mask for 5 days after;
 - EXCEPTION: (re: close contact status)
 - Classroom where mask use can be observed;
 - Outside;
 - Student is NOT considered a close contact if + person and close contact were wearing properly fitted mask;
 - Rapid Antigen Testing Recommendations:
 - Test upon notification of exposure; then
 - Every other day through day 7 (min. Of 3 times with 1 test on day 5 or later)
 - Isolation:
 - 5 days (asymptomatic or symptomatic)
 - Fever free for 24 hours without use of fever-reducing medication;
 - Symptoms are resolving;

- 5 days of consistent and correct masking when around others
