Revised Covid Flowchart 1-10-2022

Staff or Student reports they are positive for COVID-19

Staff or Student reports they are a Close Contact or Household Contact Staff or Student has a fever 100.4 or greater

Staff or Student will isolate from school 5 days from symptom onset or positive test. May return to school on day 6 if asymptomatic. Staff or student will test on day 6 and wear a mask day 6-10.

Staff or Student who are close or household contacts and **asymptomatic** can continue to be in school for their required 5 day "modified quarantine" with testing and masked.

Will continue to mask through day 10 and will test on days 1,3,5 and 7 Staff or Student/Parent should contact their primary care physician for guidance on whether testing is required.

> May return after fever free for at least 24 hours, without the use of fever reducing medication.

Staff or Student reports someone in their home was exposed to someone who is positive for Covid

If someone at home is not symptomatic but just 'exposed,' staff or student may come to school.

There is no need to self- isolate if the staff or student is a contact of a contact.

If day 6 test is positive student will go home and quarantine day 6-10

If experiencing symptoms contact physician:

Fever (100.4 or higher) New loss of taste or smell Shortness of Breath

Diarrhea Vomiting Chills

Nausea/Vomiting

congestion/runny nose muscle/body aches

Sore Throat
