

EGF ISD 595 Quarantine and Isolation Procedures (updated on 1.17.22)

COVID-19 Positive Students Or Staff:

A person who tests positive for COVID-19 must be isolated for at least 5 days from the onset of symptoms or the test date, whichever comes first.

- The person may end isolation after five (5) full days and return on day six (6) if:
 - symptoms have improved,
 - fever free for 24 hours without use of fever reducing medication,
- The person must wear a well fitted mask for ten (10) full days while around others inside your home and in school. If you choose not to wear a mask when in school, you will need to isolate for the full ten (10) days.

Household Close Contacts:

The following procedures will be followed someone in a household tests positive for COVID-19:

- **Fully vaccinated and asymptomatic individuals will not be required to quarantine.**
The school district highly recommends wearing a mask for ten (10) full days from the last day of exposure to the positive person.
 - Watch for symptoms for ten (10) full days.
 - If an individual develops symptoms, the person must isolate immediately, take a lab confirmed test, and notify the school building of attendance with the results.
- **Individuals who are not fully vaccinated or within the ninety (90) day COVID-19 positive window** will need to quarantine for five (5) full days from the last day of exposure to the positive person. The individual may return to school on day six (6) if symptom free.
 - The individual must wear a well fitted mask for ten (10) full days while around others inside the home and in school. If individuals choose to not wear a mask while in school, they will need to isolate for the ten (10) full days
 - Individuals who develop symptoms must isolate immediately, take a lab confirmed test, and notify school of attendance with the results..
