 - d. Signed permission slips for the following:
 - i. Media release
 - ii. Parent permission to participate in program
 - iii. Network Academy Cisco Training Permission slip
 - iv. Field trips authorization for the year.
- 2. All applications will be reviewed and evaluated. See the back of this page to learn how the applications will be evaluated.
- 3. The CyberPatriots will be announced the first week of May.
- **4.** A **membership fee of \$100** paid <u>after acceptance</u>. (*Option 1*: Payment at the Bookstore, *Option 2*: Vail Tax Credits)

OVMS Hawk Tech Cyber Patriots Application

By filling out and signing this application, students and parents agree that the following requirements are expected of the OVMS Hawk Tech Cyber Patriots Team:

7th-8th grade students who are in good academic and behavioral standing, are eligible for the OVMS Hawk Tech Cyber Patriots Team.

AFA Cyber Patriots limits the size of teams and only 30 students will be chosen based on the quality of their application, resume, and recommendations from teachers.

Meetings will take place twice a week @7:15am. Days **TBD** and one Saturday a month at Pima Community College(PCC) East Campus. We will meet in Bldg 700. The first meeting is **TBD**.

In order to maintain your spot in the club:

- Students must <u>consistently</u> attend club meetings.
- Students must know and adhere to the program ideals.
- Students will maintain positive interactions with other members. (There will be zero tolerance for bullying and harassment.) This is part of the program ideals.
- Students are attentive to the person talking and controlled in their behavior.
- Students will maintain passing grades in all classes.
- Students receiving any major discipline referrals may lose their place on the team. Two or more minor disciplinary incidents may also be considered for dismissal. Dismissal is at the discretion of the coach.
- Students are expected to work diligently and collaboratively with the other members of the program. This is NOT a social club or "play time" club. If you are wasting valuable work time you will be asked to leave.
- Students must use care when using computer equipment.

Dear Parents,

This school year, students will be using Cisco Network Academy as an educational tool that will allow them to go through self-paced courses and complete assignments related to these lessons. The use of this web-based software and application is intended to further prepare students for Cyber Patriot competitions. These courses will be assigned by the instructor, Mrs. Matias, and progress will be monitored.

The Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) protects the online privacy of children under the age of 13 and requires web-based service providers such as Cisco to obtain parental consent prior to the use of this program. Due to COPPA's requirements and just like any other web- or cloud-based educational tool, Cisco requires that schools obtain parental consent to allow students under the age of 13 to access and use those accounts. Any child under 13 will need to have an account created under the parent to be monitored. When you create an account for your child, please email the sponsor(matiasm@vailschooldistrict.org with login information to be able to access the courses during our meetings. If your child works on courses at home, it must be under parental supervision.

If your child is under 13, we need your consent for your child to be able to participate in the academy. Please sign below and return the slip as soon as possible!
