## Revised Covid Flowchart 1-18-2022

Staff or Student reports they are **positive for COVID-19** 

Staff or Student reports they are a Household Contact Staff or Student has a fever 100.4 or greater

Staff or Student reports someone in their home was exposed to someone who is positive for Covid

Staff/Student will isolate from school 5 days from symptom onset or positive test.

May return to school on day 6 if **asymptomatic.** 

Staff/student will wear a mask day 6-10.

Staff/Student who are household contacts and asymptomatic can continue to be in school for their required 5 day "modified quarantine."

Staff/Student will mask day 1-10. Staff/Student will be tested to stay in school if

symptoms develop.

Staff/Student/Parent should contact their primary care physician for guidance on whether testing is required.

> May return after fever free for at least 24 hours, without the use of fever reducing medication.

If someone at home is not symptomatic but just 'exposed,' staff or student may come to school.

There is no need to self- isolate if the staff or student is a contact of a contact.

## If experiencing symptoms contact physician:

Fever (100.4 or higher) New loss of taste or smell

Shortness of Breath

Diarrhea Vomiting Chills

Nausea/Vomiting

congestion/runny nose muscle/body aches

Headache
Sore Throat
Cough
Ear Pain
