Revised Covid Flowchart

Staff or Student reports they are **positive for COVID-19**

Staff/Student will isolate from school **5** days from symptom onset or positive test.

May return to school on day 6 if **asymptomatic**.

Staff/student will wear a mask day 6-10.

Staff or Student reports they are a **Household Contact**

Staff/Student who are household contacts and **asymptomatic** can continue to be in school for their required 5 day “modified quarantine.”

Staff/Student will mask day 1-10.

Staff/Student will be tested to stay in school if symptoms develop.

Staff or Student has a fever 100.4 or greater

Staff/Student/Parent should contact their primary care physician for guidance on whether testing is required.

May return after fever free for at least **24** hours, without the use of fever reducing medication.

Staff or Student reports someone in their home was exposed to someone who is positive for Covid

If someone at home is not symptomatic but just ‘exposed,’ staff or student may come to school.

There is no need to self-isolate if the staff or student is a contact of a contact.

If experiencing symptoms contact physician:

Fever (100.4 or higher)	congestion/runny nose
New loss of taste or smell	muscle/body aches
Shortness of Breath	Fatigue
Diarrhea	Headache
Vomiting	Sore Throat
Chills	Cough
Nausea/Vomiting	Ear Pain
