All students will be placed in English, math, reading, science, social studies, rotation (fine arts, physical education, and keyboarding/health), and Academic Opportunity classes.

Advanced Courses-a block of Advanced classes will be offered for all core content areas. These classes will consist of a more rigorous curriculum. **Parents/Guardians who would like to enroll their child to be in Advanced courses must come to Washington Middle School to complete the necessary consent form. This must be completed by May 1, 2023 to be guaranteed consideration for this program. Not filling out this consent form or not meeting the required deadline will result in your student being placed on a waiting list and considered for placement as spots are available.**

Gifted and Talented Students will be serviced through Advanced class offerings with monthly pullouts. If a student is failing any Advanced courses at the end of a semester, they may be removed from the program.

All students will receive at least 1 elective. Students who are considered to be meeting grade level or close to grade level expectations will receive a 2nd elective. Those students who are significantly below grade level will be placed in a Tier 3 intervention class to address math, literacy, or both. We try to ensure that a student gets at least 1 of their top 3 choices as an elective, but some electives are size limited. Students will be assigned to electives as space is available. **After electives are assigned, changes will not be made unless there are extenuating circumstances and must be approved by an administrator.**
