

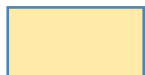

The data we use is a two week average for the percentage. If the actual Covid number is up we can go sooner.

- Excluding according to symptoms listed above (household contacts); ventilation maintained to building; hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette encouraged; masks required on bus; encouraged to stay home when sick; Home test kits offered to families as needed, if supply; high-touch surfaces cleaned in the evening; masks welcome but not required



- Increased awareness of s/s monitoring in classroom setting, increased ventilation: open windows when able, outdoor class when able; increased cleaning: mid-day cleaning of desks and high touch surfaces; excluding according to symptoms listed above (household contacts), social distance in classroom as able, make effort to accommodate increased social distancing during sports. Masks recommended in school building but not required; masks required on buses.



- Social distancing for elementary lunch (6 to a table); Close contacts will be asked to mask for 14 days or go into quarantine. Screening of visitors; masks highly recommended in building; masks required on buses.



- Quarantine close contacts, exclude according to decision tree, and restrict non-essential visitors, Masks required x 14 calendar days for all in building at all times, masks required on buses.



- Consider DL for 14 days; Consider masks on sidelines; Consider implementing other strategies as related to sport activities
