New Mental Health Health Days in School

On January 1, 2022 - the Illinois legislature passed a law to allow students to take up to five mental health days. Public - Act 102-266, House Bill 576 states: "The Compulsory Attendance Article of the School Code is amended to allow students to take up to five absences for mental or behavioral health;

after the second mental health day, they may be referred to the appropriate school support personnel."

It is the intention of Newark District 66 policy to refer students who take two mental health days (consecutive or not) to the district nurse and/or social worker.

The purpose of the bill is not intended for extra vacation days for students. Newark CCSD 66 takes our student mental health seriously

and we will help refer to services whenever we can help students.

Board of Education Policy Updates!

Under Policy 6:60 (Curriculum) - the board voted NOT to offer the NSES - National Sex Education Standards. We will continue with our own curriculum following the current standards - NOT the new ones.

The board policy committee reviews new policies, changes and updates as we receive them from the Illinois Association of School Boards three to four times a year. Policy committee meetings are posted and open to the public. The board conducts a first read and then adopts on the second read. The IASB then updates our policy manual. The Newark CCSD Board of Education Policy Manual is online on our website: www.ngsd66.org under the Board of Education tab. Scroll down to the bottom. The updated manual from this last policy approval will be available in the next few weeks.

Reminder - parents and students are not allowed to take pictures or videos of Zoom or Google Meets sessions. Sharing classroom videos or pictures without consent is a direct violation of the Illinois School Student Records Act and the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act and is contrary to our District policy regarding participation in Zoom instruction.

Dear Newark CCSD 66 Parents and Guardians,

Beginning **January 11**, students and teachers across Illinois will have an opportunity to participate in the ninth annual statewide Illinois 5Essentials Survey. This survey is designed to generate a detailed picture of the inner workings of your child's school. As a parent, this opportunity will allow you to share your thoughts on the important elements of school effectiveness in a survey about your child's school.

On behalf of the Illinois State Board of Education, the Illinois 5Essentials Survey will be administered online by UChicago Impact at the University of Chicago. The survey gathers data related to five indicators that can predict important student outcomes, including improved attendance and larger test score gains. These five indicators that affect and predict school success are:

- · Effective Leaders
- Collaborative Teachers
- Involved Families
- · Supportive Environments
- · Ambitious Instruction

Prior research in more than 400 schools has shown that schools that were strong on at least three of these "5Essential" indicators were 10 times more likely to improve student learning gains in math and reading than those that were weak on three or more Essentials.

All teachers and **4th**th **through 12**th **grade students** will be responding to this survey. 5Essentials Reports will be generated for schools if their teachers and/or students meet the response rate threshold of 50 percent. These reports will be sent to schools and districts in April 2022 and will also be included in the State School Report Card.

Additionally, your district has chosen to provide the optional Parent Supplement survey. If at least 20 percent of Newark Grade School and Millbrook Jr. High parents complete this survey, a parent supplement report will also be generated. The parent data will not be reported on the State Report Card.

Your participation in the parent portion of the survey will help us understand the conditions at your child's school and guide improvement. Your identity and survey responses will be kept completely confidential and will never be connected to you or your child.

The Illinois 5Essentials Survey for students and teachers will be conducted January 11, 2022 through March 11, 2022. The Parent Survey Supplement will be conducted during that same timeframe.
