Sand Creek Community Schools 2021-22 Positive or Close Contact Students Students that are not permitted to attend school in a face to face setting need to follow the guidelines below.

Teachers will be posting daily assignments for their individual classes in google classroom by 8:00 a.m. of the next school day. For example: A teacher gets notified on Monday that a student that they have in their class has to be quarantined, that teacher will post Monday's assignment/s for that student and for that class at least by Tuesday 8:00 a.m.

A student can email teachers during the course of the school day (business day), using their SC email, with any questions or concerns however, the teacher has 24 hours (1 business day) to reply to this email. If a student sends an email to a teacher after normal school hours on a Friday or any time during a Saturday or Sunday, the teacher will still have 24 hours (all day Monday) to respond to the email.

If a student needs materials from school (or their locker), please contact the main office and provide staff with which materials are needed and we can arrange for them to be picked up during the school day. These absences will not count towards exam absences (for Jr High students only). However, if a Jr High student is taking a high school credit class (i.e. Spanish or Alg. I) they have to take the exam for those classes. Also, quarantined absences will not count towards the 10-day school absence policy.

To keep students on task, completing daily assignments in a timely fashion as well as not putting off work until they return to school and have double the work to complete, the expectation is that the students will check postings in each of their classrooms daily. The goal of the student should be to complete the assignments as posted and by the due date. Students will need to know when daily assignments are due.

If unable to make a deadline for an assignment, **the student will have up to 48 hours from the original posted due date to turn in the assignment to that teacher**. For example, if an assignment has a posted due date of <u>8am on December 1</u> then the student <u>has until 8am on December 3</u> to submit to the teacher. The student needs to notify the teacher upon submission.

Please note: An individual teacher reserves the right to extend the deadline for any assignment as they deem necessary. STUDENTS should be communicating with their teacher/s with any questions or issues.

Every student is expected to turn in their assignments. These assignments are being graded and count towards each student's grade. These assignments are not optional. If students do not turn in their assignments on time, they will be scored as zeros which could translate to a failing grade for the class and loss of HS credit.
