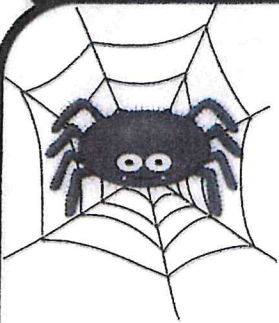




# October

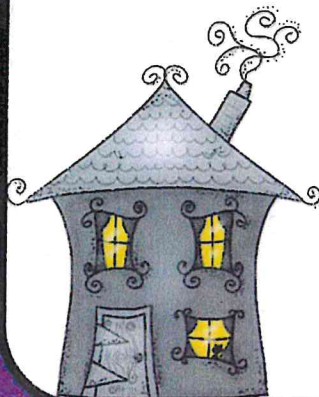
