Distinguishing features of the class: A Tutor is appointed by the Board of Education to provide academic intervention services, under the general supervision of the Building Administrator, and in conjunction with the primary instructor.

Typical Work Activities:

The incumbent would perform academic intervention services in conjunction with the instructor who is providing primary educational services to students under the direction of the School Building Administrator

Qualifications:

Bachelor's Degree is required, NYS Certification is preferred.
