The 1st Reading of Policy BFC: Board Policy Development and Adoption and was followed by a brief discussion by Baldwin on the how the Board policy website worked.

The 1st Reading of Policy BFCA: Board Regulations and Handbooks was read.

The 1st Reading of Policy BFF: Suspension of Policies and Regulations was read.

Fosheim moved, to adopt the following resolution authorizing the transfer of funds by the Business Manager from Capital Outlay fund to General fund, seconded by Roggow.

RESOLUTION #2-2022 – Let it be resolved that the School Board of the Stanley County School District #57-1 transferred the following cash balance from Fund 21 Capital Outlay to the Fund 10 General.

Terri Mehlhaff, Elementary Principal, updated the board on the elementary. Christina Merrill received December Elementary Staff of the Month. Mehlhaff thanked the board members and student council members that judged the Christmas door decorating contest. Misty Roberts was chosen the winner and her and her students enjoyed cookies from the Student Council. The Elementary concert and Cheyenne program were both great. Stephanie Weideman, the PBIS coach, came in and spoke at in-service about best teaching practices and effective response strategies to use in the classroom. The staff will meet with Mrs. Mehlhaff on their Independent Growth Plans or Student Learning Objectives by the end of January. Five staff competed the coursework for RBT through TeachWell out of Sioux Falls. Title I continues to work towards the Title I goals approved in July. Superintendent Baldwin updated the board on the January 3 in-service and all first semester evaluations were to be filed Monday.

Fosheim moved to declare the Board in Executive Session for SDCL 125-2 (1) Personnel at 6:54 P.M., seconded by Kleinsasser. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Cronin declared board back in open session at 8:19 P.M.

Fosheim moved to authorize Business Manager to offer Renae Remmele a contract as 3rd grade teacher in the amount of \$21,226.65 for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year, seconded by Roggow. All in favor. Motion carried.

Kleinsasser moved to authorize Business Manager to offer Ashley Keil a Letter of Intent as School Secretary in the amount of \$14.50 per hour for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year, seconded by Roggow. All in favor. Motion carried.

Roggow moved to authorize Business Manager to offer Sara Sterling a Letter of Intent as Elementary Educational Assistant/Computer Aide in the amount of \$12.50 per hour for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year, seconded by Fosheim. All in favor. Motion carried.

Fosheim moved to accept the resignation of Jalen Bame as MS/HS Secretary/Tech Assistant effective December 21, 2021, seconded by Kleinsasser. All in favor. Motion carried.

Kleinsasser moved to approve Jason Roggow as a volunteer for youth wrestling effective for the 2021-2022 school year, seconded by Fosheim. Roggow abstained from the vote. All in others in favor. Motion carried.

Kleinsasser moved to adjourn meeting at 8:22 P.M., seconded by Roggow. All in favor. Motion carried.
