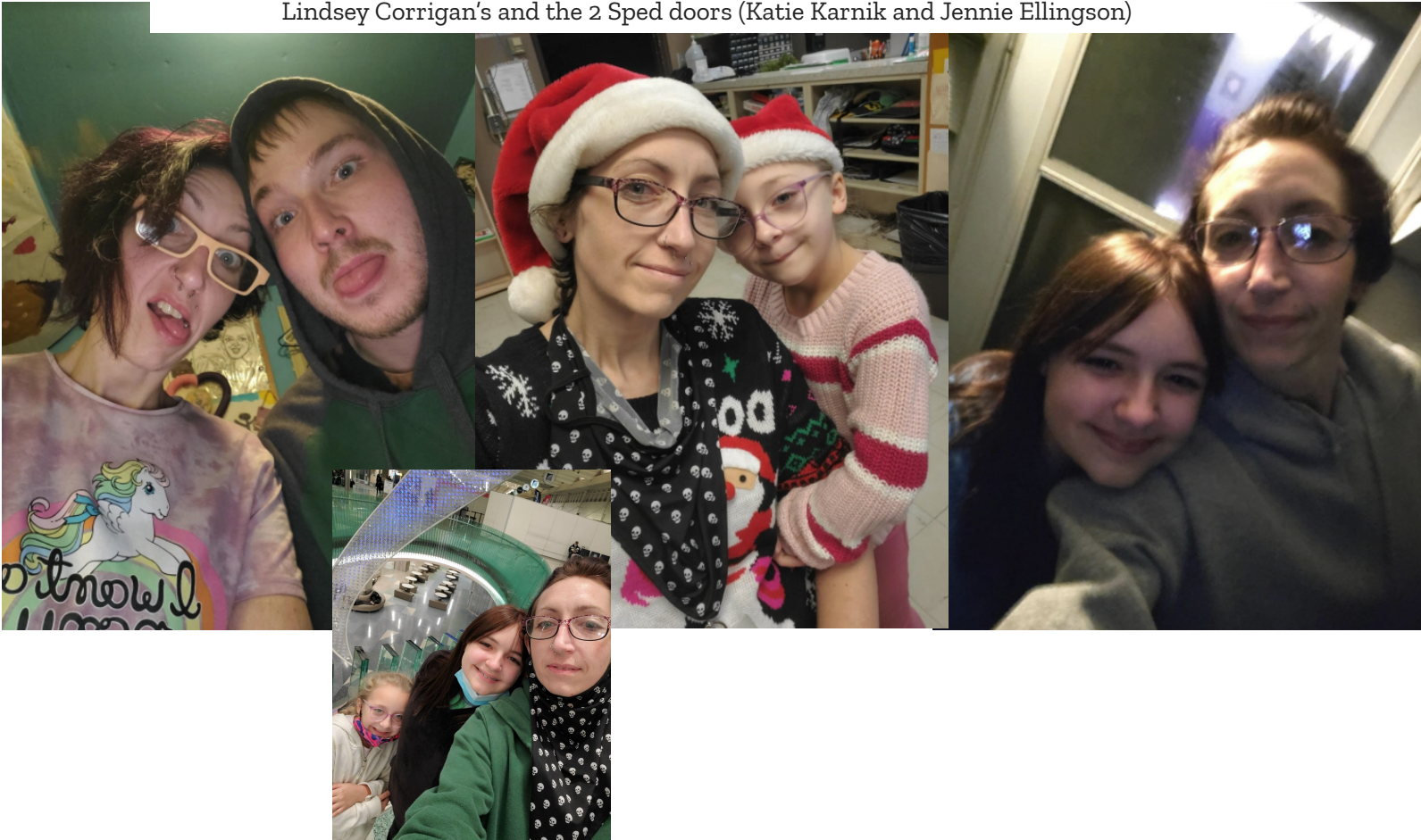
A bit about Angel:

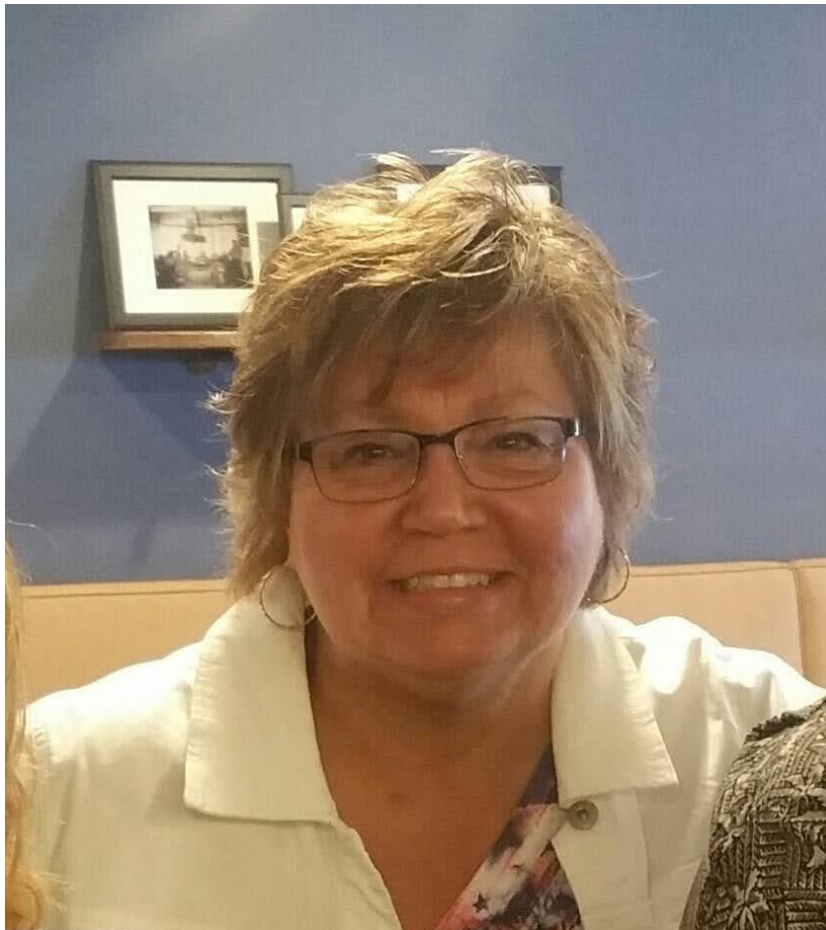
A bit about Judy:
