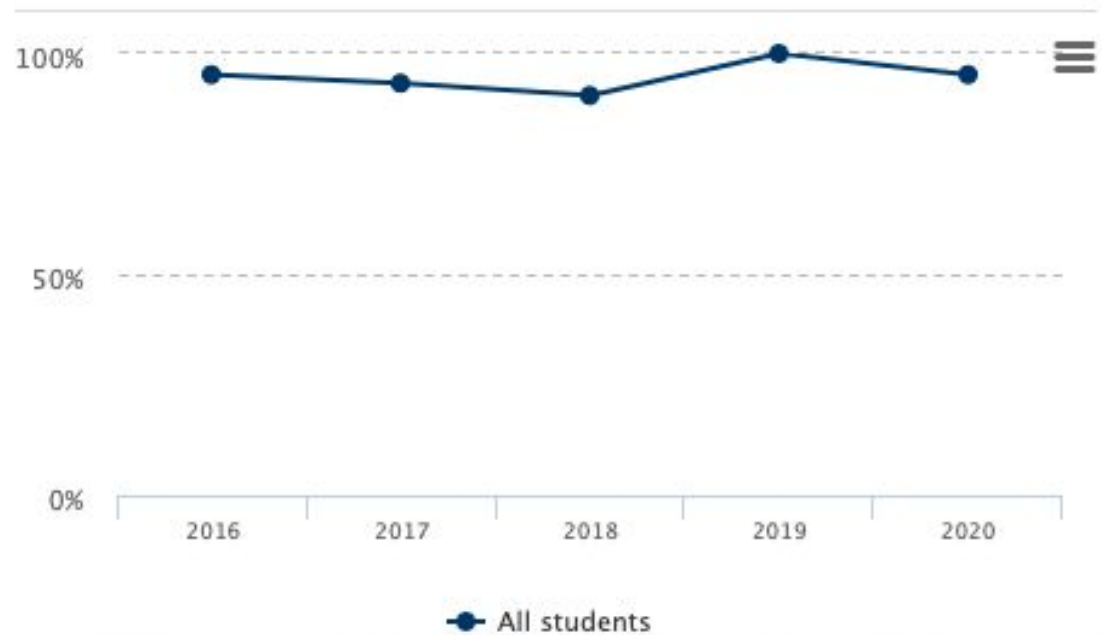

Graduation rate over time



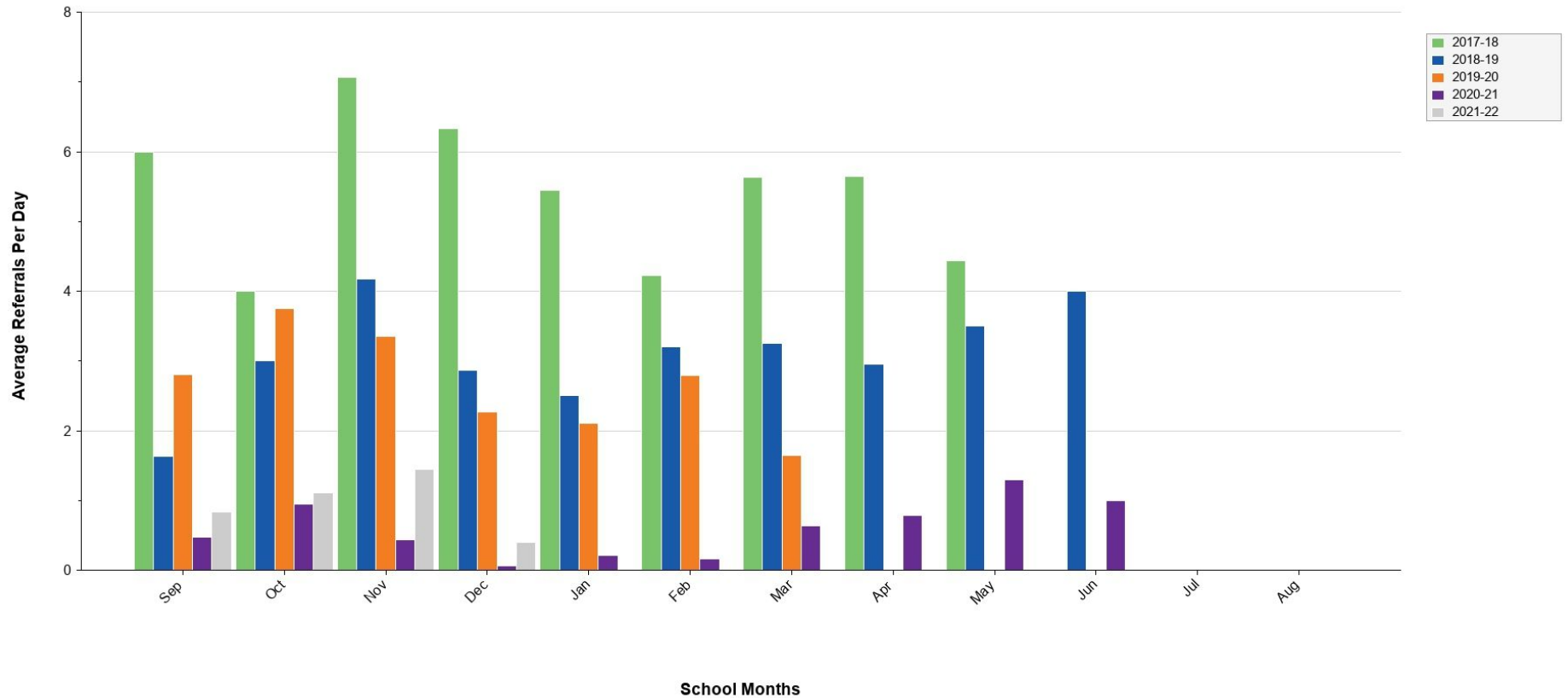
