- 1. Members Present: Trinity Edwards, Emily Noble, Holly Wasson, Rebecca Micenheimer, Courtney Short, Laci Brimer.
- 2. May 5, 2021 meeting minutes accepted unanimously.
- 3. Revision of laws for SHAC
 - a. Laws have changed regarding SHAC. The school board of a district is required to appoint at least 5 members of SHAC.
 - b. It is a requirement that a parent member serves as the chair or co-chair of the SHAC.
 - c. Emily Noble appointed as parent co-chair for SHAC
- 4. Revised wellness policy updated and posted to the website.
- 5. Covid Update
 - a. The first covid case was the first week of August before school officially began.
 - b. Roughly over 220 students and staff members have been quarantined or isolated since.
 - c. There has been a huge decrease in cases since the beginning of October.
 - d. The district is now changing vendors for rapid testing per TEA.
- 6. CPR
 - a. Seniors completed CPR training provided by DSHS.
- 7. Courtney presented the Food Services Report:
 - a. Summer feedings will resume in 2022 summer for all children through the age of 18. Locations for food pick-up were discussed.
 - b. Meals will continue to be free of charge through the remainder of this school year.
- 8. Rebecca Micenheimer presented for Communities in Schools.
 - a. She utilizes resources in the community and surrounding areas to supply clothes, food, tutoring, and help for parents finding jobs.
 - b. She has started a boys outreach program with men from the community. That will begin in the Spring of 2022.
 - c. Rains added a CIS personnel at the primary campuses.
- 9. Questions:
 - a. What about vaccine clinics? Rains ISD has hosted 2 clinics.
 - b. Is Rains ISD required to gain permission from parents to vaccinate and test? Rains ISD does not perform the vaccinations, we simply provide a location for clinics to set up. Yes, permission has to be granted from the parent for the student to receive a vaccination from this clinical site. Yes, Rains ISD requires permission from to perform a covid test on a student.
