Superintendent Lovato explained to the Board that backdated financial reports will be presented in February now that the audit is almost complete and the budget is done. He recommended tabling the financial report until February. **THE FINANCIAL REPORT WAS TABLED UNTIL FEBRUARY**

8. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Superintendent Lovato informed the Board that insulation installation in the bus barn is on hold until the weather warms up. The bus barn is functional and Mr. Jackson is excited about the lift and being able to work on the buses.

The S-CAP review date is February 28-March 1. This will be an in-person review.

Superintendent Lovato shared with the Board there is valley community interest in starting a soccer program at the Junior/Senior High School. He said he wouldn't rule out the possibility of adding another sport, but the hardest part is practice and game time as we share our stadium with Otero Junior College and their soccer team. Superintendent Lovato said he would support a co-op with Swink or Rocky Ford and said he informed Swink he would support a co-op if Swink would host the program. He also stated CHSAA supports a two-year cycle, so it would be two years from this year to start the program. Superintendent Lovato said this is something that needs valley collaboration and will be further explored. He stated he feels Swink is the community that would be the best fit to host the sport. Director Bickel commented that we need to take care of the sports we currently have before adding more. She specifically stated the condition of the tennis courts and the need for more courts.
