

Dear Maple Avenue Elementary School Parents, Guardians, Students, and Staff,

This letter is to communicate that a student within the K/1 cohort tested positive Monday and a student in the 2/3 cohort and another in the 4/5 cohort tested positive Tuesday.

Due to the structure of our school day, students within any grade level may have been exposed to the infected individuals. We continue to encourage all students and staff to continually monitor for symptoms. Please see the second page for the new protocols.

Per protocol, please follow the recommendations as outlined in the NEW <u>self-observation</u> <u>guidelines</u> by the NH Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). Please continue to come to school and self-monitor for <u>symptoms</u> for the next 14 days. No other actions are needed.
