- 252 students participated, 1039 class registrations (seats)





Revenue by WUFAR Source - Funds 10 & 27






EQUALIZED PROPERTY VALUE

The Equalized Value is the estimated value of all taxable real and personal property in each taxation district, by class of property, as of January I, and certified by DOR on August 15 of each year. General property is divided into two broad categories, real property and personal property. Real property is land, any improvements that have been attached to the land, and all fixtures, rights, and privileges pertaining thereto. Personal property includes all goods, wares, merchandise, chattels, and effects, of any nature or description having any real or marketable value, and not included in real property. General real property in the State must, by law, be divided into the following eight classes, according to use: Residential, Commercial, Manufacturing, Agricultural, Undeveloped Land, Agricultural Forest, Productive Forest Land, Other (Farm Sites & Farm Buildings, etc.)




EQUALIZED PROPERTY VALUE

TOTAL PROPERTY TAX LEVY AND MILL RATE


Mill Rate/Tax Rate - The ratio of the property tax levy to the base. This rate is determined by dividing the amount of the tax levy by either the total assessed value or the equalized value of the tax district.

It is often expressed in terms of dollars per thousand.

WATERFORD GRADED SCHOOL DISTRICT






EQUALIZATION AID

Wisconsin State Equalization Aid is general financial assistance to public school districts for use in funding a broad range of school district operational expenditures. The purposes for which general aid can be used are not restricted as they would be in a categorical aid program. Categorical aid must be used for a specific purpose or category of program, whereas general aid may be used for any expenditure the district deems necessary.




EQUALIZATION AID






DISTRICT ENROLLMENT
