We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2017-18 educational progress for the Ovid-Elsie High. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. Our high school has implemented a highly effective early warning system program to help identify students with needs. Our staff has created a tiered system of support. Students identified as Tier 1 receive general instruction supports. Students identified as Tier 2 students are provided a teaching coach in an Academic Center class to support their learning. Students identified as Tier 3 receive remedial services in math.

 - a. 277 (60%) students were represented at Parent-Teacher Conferences.

Our test results show a significant improvement from 2015-16 in all academic areas. Additionally, this upward trend is consistent with our five year improvement as a school. Ovid-Elsie High School has improved in all components of the SAT College Readiness Exam. Additionally, in the previous three years we have added eight (7) dual enrollment courses for students. We have added AP English and AP US History courses. We have added Woodworking and Welding CTE programs housed in our high school.
