

- Presentations at parent-teacher and other community organization meetings.
- Community education classes and health fairs.

The Florence County Health Department, working with administration and custodial staff, may recommend initiating or supervise facility inspection and prevention procedures at school, which may include the following:

- Teaching children to hang coats separately—placing hats/caps and gloves in the sleeves of coats and jackets.
- Storing student's possessions in individual cubbies, lockers or even individual plastic bags.
- Teaching children not to share clothing, hats/caps, helmets, headsets or personal grooming articles. It is recommended that individual combs be distributed on picture day.
- Storing towels, smocks and gym clothing brought from home in separate cubbies and encouraging students to bring them home frequently for washing.
- Exercising particular care with try-on clothes, hats, etc., that are available for students to use in early childhood and kindergarten classes. They should be laundered on a regular basis.
