 - The district will determine the most important needs by using teacher feedback on student learning loss due to COVID. Besides teacher feedback and evaluation, the district will use state assessment indicators from the 2021 assessment and compare state assessment data from previous years for individual students and the entire student population. In addition, the district will meticulously comb through data of those students who are special needs and those who are low income.
- 2. Describe how the applicant intends to assess and address student learning gaps resulting from the disruption in educational services.3

The district plans to look at pre and post-assessments, hold discussions with the student's previous grade teachers and their current grade teachers, and use previous state assessment data. The district has hired a school-wide tutor that will work with every teacher to determine the needs of individual students. The tutor will work in the classrooms of teachers who have multiple students who need extra help. The tutor will also work with students who were remote learners due to either testing positive with COVID or were in close contact with a student who tested positive. The principal will work with the teachers in providing professional development to improve student achievement and on how best to meet the needs of students who have lost instructional time due to COVID. The teachers and principal will have academic goals for each student, and use a variety of instructional strategies to improve student

Improving student achievement will be ongoing. The principal will continuously work with the teachers, the classrooms aides, and the tutor to determine the needs of students. The needs will be determined weekly, specifically looking at improvement needs at the end of each quarter, semester, and year-end. The tutor will be hired for three years, and the summer program will be three years.
