Notes from the Nurse

When does my child need to stay home from school?

- When they are ill
- Any fever greater than 100.0 F
 - May only return to school after a full 24hrs without a fever (without the use of medication to bring it down)
- When they test positive for Covid-19
 - **Stay home for 5 days minimum**- may return when symptoms resolving and fever-free (see above)
- When they have symptoms of Covid-19 while awaiting testing – regardless of vaccination status, previous infection, or lack of symptoms
- When they are a household contact (living with the person) of someone infected with Covid-19 **AND** are either unvaccinated or not "up to date" on receiving all recommended Covid-19 vaccine doses (including booster doses)

- Stay home for 10 days minimum

When can my child continue coming to school?

- Lower risk exposures to Covid-19 in the community setting (e.g., non-household contacts)
- If they are a household contact but are “up to date” on receiving all recommended Covid-19 vaccine doses and boosters
- Unvaccinated household contacts who are within 90 days of testing positive for Covid-19 by antigen or PCR-based testing

Rochester School Dept. Registration for the 2022-2023 School Year

Registration for Rochester students who will be entering Kindergarten or first time Rochester students for the 2022-23 year, is happening February 1st at the District Office during regular business hours, 8 to 4 pm.

Early registration is important. Some kindergarten classes can fill up quickly.

Registration packets must be filled out and submitted by a parent or legal guardian with the following...

◆ **Your Child's Birth Certificate**

◆ **Your Child's Immunization and Physical Record**

◆ **Proof of Your Residency***

◆ **Legal/Court PaperWork(if applies)**

***Items accepted as Proof of Residency:**

Completed lease – Closing statement –Telephone, Electric or Cable bill

Envelopes with yellow forwarding postal sticker payroll check –bank statement –doctor's bill

Proof of residency paperwork must be current.

***Items NOT accepted as Proof of Residency:**

Property Tax bill- Water/Sewer bill – Vehicle Registration /Driver's license or Post Office Box

The law mandates that no child may start school until his/ her birth certificate, immunization records and physical exam have been processed by the school department. Your child will not be assigned to a school until all registration paperwork is complete (birth certificate, immunization records, completed registration packet).
