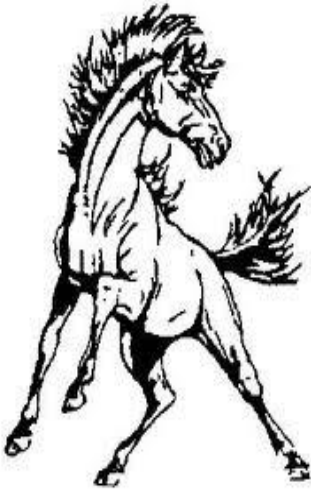

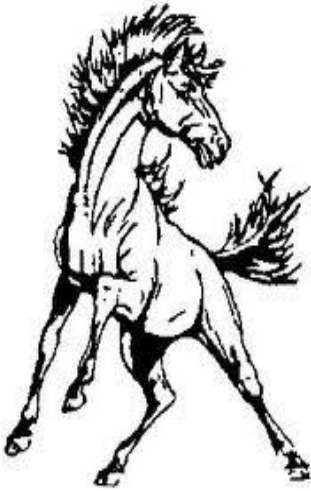

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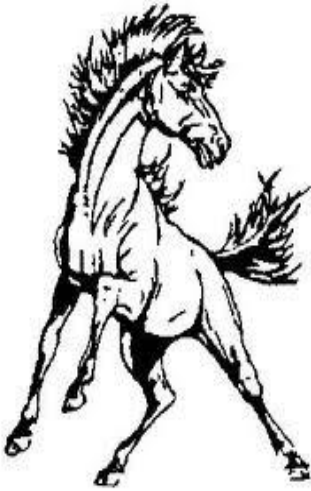

The December staff member of the month is someone who has always shown her students kindness, compassion and understanding. She creates a peaceful, yet productive environment, and she is beloved





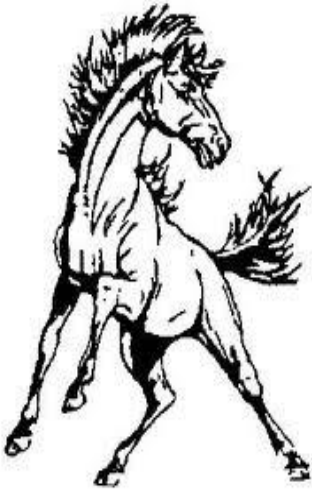
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by the student body. Our student body is very thankful for her commitment to our learning. The December staff member of the month is Mrs. Stover!
