Location

Summer School is located at Hermann Elementary School (328 West 7th Street).

Attendance

Regular attendance is strongly encouraged, but it is also understood that students and their families may have obligations that may cause them to have an occasional absence. This should not deter you from enrolling your child in the program. Your child will benefit from attending as many days of the summer school program as possible.

Transportation

Bus transportation is available; however, summer school bus routes are different from the routes during the regular school year. Students must get on and off the bus at **designated pick-up/drop-off points** OR **locations along the designated routes.** Students will not be picked-up or dropped-off at other locations. A summer school bus schedule is included in this packet for your reference. **TIMES ARE APPORXIMATE AND ROUTES MAY VARY FROM THE PRINTED SCHEDULE** depending on actual enrollment in summer school.



Meals

Breakfast and lunch will be provided **FREE OF CHARGE** to <u>ALL</u> students (18 and younger) enrolled in the summer school program through a grant provided by the Summer Food Service Program (pending approval). Students may also bring their lunch from home. (This opportunity is open to **ALL** children 18 and younger; participation in summer school is not required to join us for these healthy meals.)

<u>Attendance Incentive</u>

We plan to have an attendance incentive trip to the pool the first 3 Fridays of summer school for students with 100% attendance each week, with a possible special incentive for all students with no more than two missed days the final Friday of Summer School. This is not designed to be a punishment, rather a reward for regular summer school attendance. (Please complete the included two-sided travel release form for all trips within city limits throughout summer school. Please see the detailed information included in this packet about the pool incentive guidelines.)
