Over the years, St. Mary's Colgan High School has gone through many changes, facelifts, and developments. However, the faith, excellence, and tradition upon which the school was founded have remained strong. Because much of the information compiled for this history has been taken from past yearbooks and what people could recall, please note that this may not be entirely accurate or complete because of lack of information.

1940-1949

The 40s at St. Mary's High School was a time of new beginnings. Monsignor Patrick J. McCullough came to St. Mary's in 1928. He inaugurated the high school program in the fall of 1936 with twenty-six freshmen, adding a class each year. The first graduating class of 1940 had twenty-three graduates. Monsignor McCullough was the administrator and Sister Linus was the first principal of the high school. Both remained throughout the decade to serve in their respective capacities.

The 1940s were obviously a time of many "firsts" in the high school. In 1941, the first yearbook, *The Marian* was published, and the school song was written. The first basketball team was organized in 1940, and in 1941, the school joined the Kansas State High School Activities Association, which made St. Mary's an accredited high school.

Students were active in the early years of the high school with many clubs formed to meet the needs and interests of the diversified students. Such organizations as the boys' and girls' glee club, orchestra, camera club, Latin club, choir, chemistry and biology club, math club and Quill and Scroll were all organized during the 1940s. There was even a girls' bowling team called the Flashettes. Also of great importance was the beginning of the Sodality of the Blessed Virgin Mary, organized in 1942. The first school newspaper, The Marianette, was published that same year. Musical productions and plays were popular through the 1940s. Sister Victorine helped to organize the singing groups. The Minstrel Review was a popular musical show of the 1940s.

St. Mary's long tradition of sports' accomplishments dates back to the 1940s. Basketball was St. Mary's first competitive sport and began in 1940 under Coach Paul Stenger. In 1945, St. Mary's was the co-champs of the Mineral Belt League (MBL). Throughout the decade, the basketball teams continued to establish a winning record, capturing many district and regional wins. Football began at St. Mary's in 1945 under the leadership of Coach Arkie Hoffman. Two years later, in 1947, Adolph Spigarelli took the helm as head football coach and the Panthers won the MBL championship three straight years.

With the close of the decade brought the death of Monsignor McCullough. Other familiar names of the decade include Sister Ferdinand, Sister Luke, Sister Paula, Sister Martin, Sister Euphrasia, Sister Flavia, Sister Athanasius, Sister Clarissa, Sister Berchmans, Fr. York, and Fr. Reikas.

The decade of the 1950s began with Monsignor Alex G. Stremel as administrator. Sister Paula became principal in 1950 and remained with St. Mary's for the next eight years, followed by the return of Sister Linus. The decade had several of its own unique beginnings with the introduction of "Sadie Hawkins Day." In addition, the song "Goodnight Night Irene" became the song that the football team and student body sang to the Sisters after winning a game. The Sisters were not allowed to be away from the convent past a certain time in the evening, so singing became the teams' way of letting the Sisters know that they had won. The football team, cheerleaders and fans would then pray and sing in the Church after football games.

Fine Arts and music were a strong emphasis of the 1950s as the first band was organized. The students formed several musical groups, including The Six Teens, The Pantherettes, The Royalettes, and The Senior Care Carollers. Also organized were two other singing groups, the Blue Notes and The Madrigals. In 1952, the first Passion Play, *Calvary Hill*, written by Monsignor Stremel, was presented by members of the parish. The pep club began in 1956. The mid 1950s saw the beginnings of forensics. Inspired and encouraged by Sister Victorine, several students participated in the MBL Forensics tournaments.

To accommodate our growing school, facilities became an important focus. Monsignor Stremel's "Three Tabernacle Plan" was initiated. After three weeks as pastor, this was part of Fr. Stremel's message to the congregation. "The question is: when are the three tabernacles to be erected? We would like to build all three this summer and have it all over with. This can be done if everyone in the parish will do his or her part. All of you without doubt realize that all three are needed. Our rectory is an eye sore, we all admit; the Sister's house is too small; and the gym is needed the worst way to provide more classrooms. My dear friends, therefore let us pray that the three tabernacles will become a reality in the near future." By the end of 1952, all three were built.

A new rectory was built in 1950, and in 1951, the first basketball game was played in the new gymnasium dedicated to Monsignor McCullough. The cost of the gym was \$150,000. Also in 1951, the Sisters moved into the new convent. By 1957, plans were under way for the new high school building. Sports continued to grow strong during the decade. Football teams captured MBL championships, including in the fall of 1954, 1956, 1957 and 1958. "Spig" continued as both football and basketball coach until the arrival of Lon Farrell in 1955. Lon brought with him an enthusiasm that would last for many years. In 1957, the basketball team won the MBL championship and followed with another in 1958. In the spring of 1956, the first baseball team took the field.

Other memorable names of the decade were Sister Vincentia, Sister Rosalia, Sister Lucille, Sister de Pazzi, Sister Lucinanna, Fr. Pepe, Fr. Kocour, Fr. Bartos, and Fr. Hughes. Mrs. Lillian Johnson began as school secretary in 1957 and served the school for 27 years, retiring in 1984.

The decade of the 1960s brought many changes to St Mary's. From 1959 to 1969, the high school was under the leadership of five different administrators and four different principals. Monsignor Stremel was followed by Monsignor Charles A. Smith as administrator until 1965. In 1965, Fr. Thomas Colgan served as administrator. On July 24, 1966, Fr. Colgan was tragically killed in an automobile accident. Fr. Leroy Linnebur followed by Fr. Leo Kerschen served as administrators for the remainder of the decade. Sister Linus served as principal until the end of 1960 and was followed by Sister de Chantal then Sister Veronica. In 1966, the "luck of the Irish" brought us Sister Mary Patrick as principal, to finish the decade. Because of the transient administration, it was somewhat difficult to maintain a feeling of stability during this decade. In 1960, St. Mary's High School moved out of the third floor of the Elementary School and across the street to its own building. The class of 1960 was the first to proudly graduate from the new building.

Band and chorus continued to be strong through the sixties. Also established in the 1960s was the National Honor Society and Student Council. Flag twirlers, majorettes, cheerleaders, and pep club remained active. In 1968, *Brigadoon*, the first school musical, was presented under the direction of Sister Mary Patrick. This began a long tradition of musicals. In 1969, Sister also directed the musical *Camelot*. During the 1960s, the yearbook was changed from *The Marian* to *Image*.

Sports continued to play a big role in the school. Lon Farrell coached the 1959 and 1960 football teams to their fourth and fifth consecutive MBL championships. Lon left in 1961 to assume other coaching duties, but was followed by another legendary coach, Frank Crespino, who won his first MBL championship in 1961. The rest of the sixties saw great winning seasons for Coach Crespino and his teams. With football and basketball well established, interest in baseball grew rapidly. The Panthers won their first State baseball championship in 1964, followed by State championships in 1967 and 1968. Basketball, too, saw a great comeback during the 1960s. When Lon Farrell left in 1961, his basketball coaching duties were assumed by Frank Crespino for the next three years. In 1963, the basketball team placed second at State. The following year, Pat Forbes, took the helm as head basketball coach and remained as coach until 1975.

The peacefulness of the 1960s was upset at the high school with the death of Fr. Colgan in 1966. The following school year, the name of the school was changed to Colgan Regional High School with the plan for it to be supported by surrounding parishes. Several significant changes occurred during the 1960s including the completion of the high school building and renaming the school in memory of Fr. Colgan. However, these were only physical changes that did not change the faith, which was the driving force of the school.

The 1970s was a decade that brought continued success and tradition. Fr. Eugene Grabner served as administrator from 1970-1971 and was followed by Fr. Edward Steinberger for the rest of the decade. Sister Mary Patrick remained as principal until 1972 and was replaced for one year by Sister Laura. In 1973, Mr. Patrick Forbes became our first lay principal.

Drama productions continued to be strong during the 1970s. Sister Mary Patrick directed and produced *Arsenic and Old Lace, Finnian's Rainbow*, and *Cinderella*. The following year after Sister's departure, the students performed *South Pacific*. In the fall of 1973, Robert Tindel joined the staff and continued with a long line of musical and dramatic productions. A few of these presentations included *Hello Dolly, Mame, Funny Girl, Fiddler on the Roof* and *No, No, Nanette*. As the popularity of the productions grew, the drama club became a thriving organization.

One of the unique happenings of the 1970s was the beginning of organized girls sports. Girls track began in 1973, following by tennis in the fall of 1973 and both volleyball and basketball in 1974. In 1978, the girls tennis team had an individual State Champion, followed by a state runner up in 1979. Pom-Pon began in 1975 under the direction of Sister Suzanne.

The decade was a memorable one for football, winning back-to-back State Championships in 1974 and 1975. Coach Frank Crespino was named 1975 Kansas Coach of the Year with an unbelievable 33 game winning streak. His team earned the title of CNC league champs in 1974, 1975, 1977, 1978, and 1979. At the close of the 1979-80 school year, after 19 years of coaching, Frank Crespino retired as football coach, posting a record of 153 wins, 37 losses, and 4 ties.

Boys basketball had some exceptional seasons during the 1970s. In 1969-70, under Pat Forbes, the basketball team won all of its games except one. However, at that time, Colgan did not belong to a league; therefore, there was no league championship to garner. The baseball team was also gaining attention. CHS baseball won the State Championship in 1971 and 1976 and were State runners up in 1973, 1977, 1978, and 1979. The 1971 and 1973 teams were coached by Frank Crespino and the later teams were under the leadership of Jim Flax. Colgan began boys golf in 1978 under the direction of Pat Forbes.

Although the nation as a whole seemed to be in a total upheaval with the conflict in Vietnam as well as rampant drug abuse and constantly changing clothing styles and social standards, the students at Colgan were surrounded by consistent and concerned faculty helping bring stability into their lives. Many of those people included Sister Lucille, Sister Prudentia, Sister Suzanne, Sister Helen Joseph, Sister Patrice, Maggie McNeil Ryan, Ed Martin, Bob Tindel, Jim Flax, Fr. Ken Melarangno, Fr. Pat Malone, as well as the already established Forbes/Crespino duo.

The 1980s was a decade that had its own changes at Colgan. Fr. Ivan Eck arrived in 1981 to replace Fr. Steinberger as administrator. Pat Forbes remained as principal throughout the decade. Following Fr. Steinberger and Fr. Eck as administrators, the school was led by Fr. William Carr for one year, followed by the arrival of Fr. Tom Stroot in 1988. The decade also brought with it the resignation of longtime coach, teacher, and vice-principal Frank Crespino in 1987, after 26 years of selfless service to the school. Prompted by a conversation between Fr. Eck and a public school bus driver who did not know Colgan was a Catholic school, the school was renamed in 1987 to Colgan St. Mary's. In 1989 it was switched to St. Mary's Colgan. Our Lady of Lourdes Parish celebrated its 100th anniversary in 1981.

The drama department continued to produce plays including *George M, Finnian's Rainbow*, *Oliver, Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat, My Fair Lady, Camelot, Harvey, Oklahoma*, and *You're a Good Man Charlie Brown*. From 1981 to 1986, the plays were under the direction of Bob Tindel. During the spring of 1988, the Alumni Association organized and produced the original version of *Calvary Hill*, written by Monsignor Stremel. Members of the parish and community, as well as the high school and grade school students were involved.

A highlight of the 1980s was the organization of debate and forensics/speech by Bob Tindel. The squads began competition in the fall of 1981. In 1983, the speech team won the CNC league tournament and went to State. Colgan brought home team State Champions in Speech in both 1985 and 1986 as well several individual State Championships. Debate placed in the top five at State in 1983, 1984 and 1985 and reached second place in 1986.

Success in sports continued during the decade. In the fall of 1980, Chuck Smith assumed head football coaching duties. In 1983 and 1984, the team was district champs. Colgan won three straight CNC league championships in 1983, 1984, and 1985. The 1984 team earned Coach Smith his first State Championship. The team also won district championships in 1988 and 1989. Boys golf continued in the 1980s under the direction of Fr. Eck, a role later assumed by Ed Martin. Track and cross-country earned many regional wins during the 1980s, which qualified runners for State competition on numerous occasions. In 1986, the girls 4 x 400 relay team placed second in the State. The volleyball team, under Coach Ed Martin, was the 1981 CNC league co-champs and the CNC league champions in 1982. Boys basketball became strong once again in the 1980s with the arrival of Wayne Cichon as head coach. In 1985, the team went to the State Tournament for the first time since 1971. In 1986, Cichon lead the team to become the CNC league champions. The team made return trips to State in 1986 and 1988. Baseball also posted many wins during the decade, going to the State Tournaments in 1983, 1984, 1985, 1988, and 1989. Chuck Smith coached the team from 1981 to 1984, and in 1985, Mike Watt took over as head baseball coach.

The 1990s were a decade that brought many physical changes to campus as our students continued their strong tradition in academics and athletics. Fr. Tom Stroot and Pat Forbes served as administrator and principal, respectively, throughout the decade.

The campus began to take on a new personality in 1991 with the completion of the St. Mary's Activity Center. Incorporated in the approximate 2,800 square feet of the Activity Center was a new lunchroom, gymnasium, and several shower facilities for the athletic teams. In addition, two new meeting areas, an after-school program and the Religious Gift Shop were housed in the Activity Center. The SMC Activity Center has proven to be an invaluable asset, hosting wedding receptions, assemblies, conferences, and parish gatherings.

Looking forward to the future and continued growth, school board members, administration, and teachers developed a plan to meet these needs. Phase I was the completion of the grade school's new heat and air system. The high school heat and air update soon followed. Phase II included a 14,000 square foot addition to the high school building. This addition included two high school science labs, a junior high science lab, and four junior high classrooms with a library and media center accessed by both the high school and junior high. This moved the junior high out of the grade school and into the high school building. Phase III consisted of renovating the auditorium which added two classrooms in addition to the new theater. Sports accomplishments continued in the '90s. The SMC track team won State in 1993. The football team was State Runner up in 1991. Baseball saw success with State championships in 1993, 1998, and 1999 with State appearances in 1992, 1997. Boys basketball won State in 1996, and made State appearances in 1997, 1998, and 1999. The girls basketball team made a State appearance in 1996. The volleyball team made it to State in 1993 and 1997. The golf team brought home the State Championship in 1996, while they were State runner-up in 1993. The first Girls' Softball team took the field in 1995.

SMC produced a State Championship Team in Scholar's Bowl in 1993. Debate and forensics teams continued to shine throughout the 1990s and the drama department entertained and amazed its patrons. Performances included: Arsenic & Old Lace, Barefoot in the Park, Little Shop of Horrors, The Miracle Worker, The Best Christmas Pageant Ever, Starting Monday, Past Tense/Present Tense, Sister Sister, Eleeemosynary/To Burn A Witch, The Nerd, Song at the Scaffold, A Christmas Carol, The Song of Bernadette, While the Lights Were Out, Winners & Who's On First, Fortress, All Out, God's Favorite, and Guys and Dolls completed the decade. The St. Mary's Colgan High School and Elementary schools have seen a notable increase in student population since 1992. This increase required the grade school to grow from one classroom per grade level to two.

The parish and schools continued to flourish under the guidance of Fr. Stroot. Mr. Pat Forbes retired in 2005, after 32 years as principal. Dr. Bill Dickey served as interim principal of the high school/junior high. Mr. John Kraus was hired in the spring of 2006 as the President of Schools/Director of Administration and served as interim principal of the high school/jr high, for 2006-2007. Mr. Tom Gorman was hired as high school principal in 2007.

In April of 2004, a new 12,000 square foot building housing the Religious Gift Store, Goodwill, weight room and mechanical shop opened at the corner of 10th and Locust. The weight room moved from the basement of the McCullough Gym to the new fitness center. In 2003, anonymous donors approached Fr. Stroot with the offer to build a new elementary school. After prayerful consideration, the donation was accepted. Properties adjacent to the school were acquired, and ground was broken in the spring of 2005. The fall of 2006 saw the opening of the new St. Mary's Elementary School and tearing down of the old Elementary school. This was also the beginning of the St. Mary's Preschool. The donors also funded a large, free-standing gymnasium, giving the growing school three gymnasiums. The St. Mary's Colgan Fieldhouse was built north of the Elementary school, across 10th street. The Fieldhouse accommodates two volleyball matches simultaneously, with a total seating capacity of 1,200. State Championship banners hang proudly on the wall. In campus additions, in 2008, the Commons area was added to the front of the high school building. The addition is often the location of meetings, youth activities, as well as informal gatherings during lunch and before and after school. Included in the addition was new administrative office space and a new teacher's lounge, as well as a more secure entrance.

In 2005, a small group of students attended a Catholic youth conference sponsored by Franciscan University of Steubenville. The youth caught on fire with the Spirit and as a result the Steubenville summer youth conferences became a tradition. The outpouring of religious youth activities grew beyond Steubenville. Under the direction of the Religious Youth Coordinator and priests, a student activity was planned for each Wednesday, including Prayer and Adoration, Dead Theologians Society, and Young Apostles for the jr high students. A group for high school young men called Knights of Our Lady was started. They would meet weekly to pray a rosary and share a meal. GRACE was started for high school young women who met to pray a chaplet and share a meal. A group of adult parishioners formed the Team Jesus band playing faith-based music for the students. In 2008, under the direction of Fr. Brian Nelson, the space above the McCullough gym became dedicated for the use of youth of the parish. The former kindergarten and music room became known as the Upper Room. In 2000, the first annual Religion Bowl was held during Catholic Schools Week with the top two students from each Religion class grouped to form a four-person team. The school's tradition of May Crowning continued.

Ms. Alice Hilt returned to SMC to direct the Theater department as well as debate and forensics. The students continued the great drama tradition with performances including *Guys and Dolls*, *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dream Coat*, *Our Town*, *The Passion Play*, *Fiddler on the Roof*, The *Wizard of Oz*, *My Fair Lady* and *Harvey*. After a brief hiatus, SMC returned to competition in debate and forensics.

The football program had an amazing run including a 66-game winning streak spanning the 2000-2005 seasons. This included State Championships in 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003 and State Runner-up in 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008. In 2001, Chuck Smith was named All Class Coach of the year. Boys basketball also was very successful earning State Championships in 2000, 2002, 2005, 2006 and 2008 and State Runner-up in 2003, 2004, 2007 and 2008. Wayne Cichon was named All Class Coach of the year in 2008. SMC baseball also dominated with Mike Watt's teams winning State in 2001 followed by State Runner up in 2002 and fourth in 2003. State Championships were won in 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, and 2009.

Volleyball was also successful, making it to the State tournament in 2000, 2001 and 2007, winning 3rd place in 2001. Girls basketball also reached several milestones, reaching the State Tournament in 2007, 2008 and 2009. The young softball team saw early success, making it to the State tournament in 2001, 2004, and winning 3rd place in State in 2001, 2006, 2008 and 2009. Success carried over to the boys golf team. The team won 2rd at State in 2004 and 2008 and, 3rd at State in 2006, followed by 2A State Championship in 2009. Track had many student-athletes competing with several winning individual State Championships.

There was growth in student athletes participating with Pittsburg High School in sports SMC does not offer. These "Pittsburg Panthers" practiced and competed with the PHS teams and in individual sports competed at the 2A level for Regional and State. These include soccer, tennis, cross country, and wrestling. The dance and cheer squads at SMC continued their excellence, practicing year-round to perform at a very high level. Students also excelled in academic competitions and in national testing. Students also did well in the CNC art competition. SMC was the State Champs in Chess in 2000 and 2003 and State runner-up in 2001.

Many traditions have continued, including Singing to the Sisters after winning football games. However, on September 26, 2008, the last three members of the Sisters of St. Joseph who lived in the convent, returned to the Motherhouse in Wichita. Not wanting this tradition to die, the football players, cheerleaders and student body continued to gather on the Convent steps after a win. Sometimes they would call the Sisters in Wichita and sing over the phone, or they would serenade the local Hispanic Sisters. After the Sisters left, the chapel in the convent was renovated to become the Christ the King Adoration Chapel with adoration Monday through Friday.

After over 20 years of service to Our Lady of Lourdes and St. Mary's Colgan, Fr. Tom Stroot retired in June of 2011, and Fr. Mike Baldwin assumed the role of pastor, followed by Fr. Jerome Spexarth in June of 2018. In the fall of 2010, John Kraus became principal for the entire Pre-K – 12th grade at SMC, as well as President of Schools. Fr. Chad Arnold was then named President of Schools, Mr. Tom Compton became principal of St Mary's Colgan High School/Junior High, and Mrs. Nancy Hicks became the principal of the elementary. Fr. Chad was transferred in June of 2014. OLL parish underwent a strategic plan process called *Faith Forward, Come to the Table*. As a result, a new leadership model was adopted and in July of 2015, Mr. Dennis Burke, began the new position of Director of School Advancement. Mr. David Stephenson became jr high/high school principal in 2016, followed by Mr. Wes Streeter in 2019. Mr. Burke's title was eventually changed to President of Schools.

Through an anonymous donation, a new rectory was built on the footprint of the former rectory. The priests moved into the rectory in 2010. The Parish Office was moved into the renovated office building at the corner of 9th and Locust and no longer located in the rectory.

Between 2010 and 2015, three SMC coaches celebrated milestone victories. Coach Mike Watt took Colgan baseball to 500 wins, as well as 16 of SMC's 20 State Championships. Baseball won State in 2010, and an incredible streak of 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016. Coach Chuck Smith, who was also serving as the Kansas District 3 State Representative in Topeka, recorded over 300 career football wins. After 37 years of coaching and teaching at SMC, Chuck Smith retired in 2017. Shawn Seemater was selected as the new football coach and math teacher. Coach Wayne Cichon reached 500 wins in basketball. Another milestone was reached when the 2010 Softball team brought home the first State Championship by a girls team. The softball State Championship banner is white with blue lettering to differentiate it as a girls sport. Another white banner was hung after the 2019 Softball once again won State this time under the direction of Coach Annie Dellasega, who had played on the 2010 State Championship team. Boys golf brought home back-to-back state Championships in 2010 and 2011. The volleyball teams also had success advancing to State several years. Student athletes competed in State Cross Country and Track and Field earning several individual medals.

In addition to athletic competitions, SMC students competed in Scholar's Bowl, earning 2nd place in State in 2015. Students also competed in Eco-Meets, nurturing appreciation for the natural science and Kansas Environment. SMC won 1st place at State Eco-Meets in 2012, 2nd in 2011 and 3rd place in 2014 and 2019.

Fine Arts plays continued, including *The Miracle Worker, Much Ado About Nothing, Into the Woods, Annie, Barefoot in the Park, It's a Wonderful Life, Happy Valley High, A Christmas Carol* and *Singin' in the Rain.* Excellence continued in debate and forensics, competing at the state level with several students qualifying for national forensics competition. The SMC speech and debate program earned membership in the National Speech and Debate Association's 100 Club making them ranked in the top 10% nationally. Students also represented SMC at all district choir, as well as all-district band. The pep band performed at some of the home athletic events from 2013 to 2017. Also in 2013, the Glee Club was revived, performing at intermission of the fall play. New theater experiences began with the transition to Mrs. Lola Wade as the

theater teacher in 2016-17 school year. Plays often incorporated junior high and elementary students and were performed at a very high level. Plays included *The Wizard of Oz, A Christmas Story, The Sound of Music, Cinderella,* and *Into the Woods* as well programs to honor Veterans.

Beginning in 2010, students had the opportunity to take a Spring Break Mission trip to West Virginia to serve the people of Appalachia. To help fund the Mission Trip and other Youth Group trips such as Steubenville, "Colgan's Best Dance Crew" began in 2010 as a friendly competition featuring dance groups composed of students, teachers, parents and, the always crowd favorite, the priests. Dance Crew was a very popular fund raiser for several years.

A major Church renovation was completed in 2017. On October 14, 2017, after merely five months from the beginning of the project, Bishop Kemme dedicated our new altar and reopened the Church. Funded by parishioners, the project came in under the \$1.2 million budget. Plaster was repaired and walls repainted, as well as new pews, tile flooring on the altar and aisles with carpet under the pews, saint medallions were added on the ceiling and the crucifix was suspended above the altar. In other facility upgrades on campus, a free-standing weight room was added, just west of the practice field. The former weight room was partially incorporated into the Bargain Corner (formerly called the Goodwill) while the remaining part was turned into a small event space or meeting room for the parish/school called Guadalupe Hall.

Beginning in the 2018-19 school year, Sisters once again are teaching at SMC. Four Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary (IHM) were assigned to Our Lady of Lourdes with two teaching in the Elementary and two teaching Religion in the Jr High/High School. The fully habited Sisters are once again living in the Convent. Also in the 2018-19 school year, the Communities System was put into place in the Jr High/High School. This is a manner of organizing the student body into houses, similar to homerooms, with a mixture of grades in each house. Within the high school, three houses form each community. The students chose to name their communities: St. Padre Pio, St. Teresa of Calcutta and St. Maximilian Kolbe. Three seniors and three juniors serve as the captains. The community system fosters the building of relationships across grade and class boundaries. The junior high has four houses under one community which they named St. Philomena, with a similar student leadership structure. SMC faculty provides leadership in the form of deans and advisors over the communities.

As 2019 ended, the world was becoming aware of coronavirus, which would become known as COVID-19. The changes that were coming to our school and world were quick, unexpected, and unprecedented.

Friday, March 13, 2020, was the last day of in-person school at SMC for the 2020 school year. With growing world-wide concern for COVID-19, administration cancelled school the week prior to Spring Break. After the two-week break, the Governor of Kansas ordered that schools be closed for in-person education for the remainder of the school year. There were no spring sports, (baseball, softball, track, and boys golf), the spring play, *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*, was cancelled after weeks of rehearsal. There was no prom, senior retreat, May Crowning or graduation. Volunteers delivered sack lunches to the homes of our students who signed up. All Masses were cancelled. Continuous Learning Plans (CLP) were created for our students. Elementary parents picked up paper and pencil packets for their children to complete at home then return the next week, while JH/HS students completed the school year on zoom. High School graduation and 8th Grade Recognition were held during the summer with limited attendance and live streamed.

The 2020-21 school year began in the middle of the COVID-19 pandemic. Fr. Jerome Spexarth continued as pastor with Mr. Wes Streeter as JH/HS principal, Mrs. Nancy Hicks as elementary principal and Mr. Dennis Burke as President of Schools. Teaching and running a school during a world-wide pandemic required an incredible amount of preparation and then flexibility to adapt as the rules changed. SMC administration worked throughout the summer.

When the school year began, students were spread out to create social distancing in the church, classrooms, lunchroom, music, PE, and every interaction that students had throughout the day. Cohort groups were established to minimize exposures. Temperatures were checked every morning. Masks were worn by everyone. Plexiglass partitions were made and installed across campus to further protect students and teachers. Elementary school pick up became a dance to quickly disburse the students. Parents stayed in their cars creating a parade in the circle drive as teachers used walkie talkies to announce when parents arrived. Through a generous donation, 7th-12th grade students were each provided a Chrome Book and were prepared in the event that school went virtual. Virtual school adaptations were ready for the elementary students as well. Fall sports resumed, but with modifications created by KSHSAA, including placing limits on the number of fans allowed to attend. Athletes were each given a small number of vouchers which allowed admittance of parents/family into the games. One good outcome was that most games were live streamed allowing everyone, everywhere to watch. School plays were performed to an empty auditorium and recorded. With a careful eye to copyright laws, plays were made available for viewing digitally. In the case of an unfortunate positive COVID-19 test, the student/faculty/staff had to isolate at home and anyone who was considered a close contact had to quarantine at home (the length of time for isolation and quarantine changed during the pandemic but was approx. 10-14 days). Regulations changed with the ebb and flow of COVID-19, but school continued.

Unlike the previous year, most activities and events took place throughout the year, but many with modifications. There was a constant eye toward the Crawford County Health Department for guidance as well as ever changing regulations. As a Catholic school in the Diocese of Wichita, there was also guidance and expectations from our Superintendent of Schools, Janet Eaton. The 2021 school year ended with the retirement of St. Mary's Elementary principal, Nancy Hicks. Also, at the end of the year, the softball team won the State tournament.

As the 2021-22 school year began, there were still COVID 19 concerns. Kristen O'Brien took over as the elementary principal. The remaining administration was unchanged. After prayer and in consultation with area doctors, masks were required to start the school year. School sports and activities resumed in a more pre-pandemic way. In September, antigen testing became available on campus, and masks became optional. School plays resumed as did sports and activities including prom, class retreats and graduation. The Girls Golf team won State, for the second year in a row. The football team made a post season. State berths were earned by the volleyball team, cross country team, scholar's bowl, boys and girls basketball, baseball and softball and track. After 39 years as boys head basketball coach, Wayne Cichon stepped down at the end of the school year. Mr. Cichon will continue to teach at SMC. Instead of a Spring Break mission trip to West Virginia, students and chaperones held a "local mission trip" in early June. Students will once again attend a Steubenville conference during the summer, after two years off because of COVID-19. The students and staff have weathered the storm of COVID-19 that we pray is behind us.
