Re: 6th-12th Grade Semester Tests

Semester Tests for 6th-12th Grade students will take place on Wednesday, December 21st. Students that have achieved a letter grade of a "B" or higher in a particular class for both the 1st and 2nd Quarter grading periods will have the option to exempt themselves from taking the semester test in that class. Students with no testing obligations during a specific testing period will be granted "open campus" privileges and will not be required to be in school. Students are not required to exercise these privileges; however, if they do not, they will be required to report to the class for which they are assigned during that testing period.

If a student meets the academic criteria necessary to exempt themselves from a semester test, they still retain the option to take the test, should they so choose. In those cases, the resulting grade on the semester test will only be applied to their final semester grade if the result benefits the student. Should the grade have a negative impact upon the student, it will be disregarded. Please keep in mind that if a student does not meet the necessary academic criteria and is required to take a semester test, the resulting grade on that test will be applied to the student's final semester grade.
