WB Virtual Thursday and Friday, February 3rd and 4th

Based upon the current predictions of ice and freezing rain for tomorrow then changing to snow through tomorrow night into Friday, students will not report to school on Thursday and Friday. Western Beaver has a primary and secondary plan for academics.

The primary plan is to have live virtual instruction days on Thursday and Friday for students. Students will be expected to be on TEAMS throughout the day. The TEAMS schedule for each building and classroom will be similar to a normal school day schedule. More information regarding your child's schedule will be provided by their teacher(s).

However, should there be any power outages for students and/or staff during the planned virtual instruction, we have instructed the students on a secondary plan for instruction during the period of power outage. That plan includes students completing assignments asynchronously during the period of any power outage. As long as the teacher has power and internet access they will be providing virtual instruction via TEAMS to their classes based upon their schedule. To accommodate our Elementary students along with some necessary courses in the Jr/Sr High School, assignments will be sent home with students on Wednesday, just in case students have to complete asynchronous assignments. Fairview students, where appropriate, and Jr/Sr High School students have been provided the opportunity to download necessary work, have paper copies, and have the required work preloaded in the appropriate folders for the possibility of some asynchronous periods of instruction.

Again, unless there are disruptions of internet access and/or power due to the weather conditions, all students are expected to participate in the school's virtual instruction model. Should there be disruptions of internet access and/or power, students are to utilize the planned asynchronous instruction model during those periods. However, once internet and/or power has been restored they should then transition back to our synchronous virtual instruction model.

Assignments/Classroom Work/Attendance

Unless there are widespread internet and/or power outages attendance will be taken during each class period. However, knowing there is a possibility for internet and/or power outages; all assignments and classroom work will need to be turned in by Tuesday, February 8, and will count as the students' attendance for Thursday and Friday. Should a student not submit the work posted for their classes on these days they will be marked absent accordingly.

Activities

All school activities are canceled for Thursday. All buildings are closed on Thursday. The district will spend Friday cleaning the snow and ice accumulation and preparing the building and grounds for weekend activities. All buildings are closed during the day on Friday with the exception of necessary maintenance/custodial personnel.

<u>Meals</u>

Meals for Thursday and Friday have been prepared by our cafeteria staff and will be sent home with all students on Wednesday.
