














5 Essentials Survey

WHAT IS THE 5 ESSENTIALS SURVEY?

The 5Essentials Survey identifies five indicators that lead to improved outcomes for all students, including improved attendance and larger test score gains.

The five indicators that positively affect school success are:


- 1. Effective Leaders
- 2. Collaborative Teachers
- 3. Involved Families
- 4. Supportive Environments
- 5. Ambitious Instruction

The 5Essentials Survey usually requires no more than 20-30 minutes to complete. The information collected through the survey is rigorously reviewed and analyzed to generate a 5Essentials Report for each school. The 5Essentials Report provides a comprehensive picture of the school environment based on five essential areas critical for school improvement in a meaningful context of similar and successful schools.

Parents we need your help!!!!! We need our Algonquin parents to take the survey. In fact, after you take the survey, at the end of the survey, the final screen will say, "Thank you for taking the survey". Please take a picture of that screen and send it to your child's homeroom teacher. We will begin weekly raffles for parents who complete the survey.
