

The monthly meeting of the AC/GC Booster Club was held February 5, 2020 in the high school library. Seven members and four guests were in attendance. Crystal Hanson made a motion to fund the \$500.00 request and Julie Plowman seconded the request. The motion passed unanimously.

Julie Plowman presented a request from the A-C Elementary Carnival committee, asking for a donation for their upcoming spring carnival. Since the apparel inventory has been closed out, it was suggested to donate various boxes of candy from the club's concession stand inventory. In addition, Charger window decals will be donated. Toni Colling made a motion to donate the aforementioned items and Julie Plowman seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Cody Matthewson, Strength and Conditioning Coach, provided information about the new weight room project. There will be a Kick-Off Fundraiser on March 21st. Mr. Matthewson asked the Boosters to be a lead sponsor for the project. Julie Plowman made a motion to pledge \$50,000.00 toward the project over the course of the next three years. Suzanne Bunde seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

In Old Business, Superintendent Dennis McClain reported he has been in contact with Mrs. Nielsen regarding the design of Visitor/Home signs for the gymnasium. She is currently exploring possible design and material avenues.

In New Business, members were reminded of the first home track meet to be held April 16th. A date and time for concession stand clean-up will be determined next month.
