Code of Ethics for Academy Board Members

As a member of the Governing Board of The Academy Inc., I will strive to improve student achievement in education, and to that end I will:

- 1. Attend all regularly scheduled board meetings in so far as possible, having read my packet ensuring that I am informed about the issues to be considered at the meetings;
- 2. Render all decisions based on the available facts and my independent judgment, and refuse to surrender that judgment to individuals or special interest groups;
- 3. Work with other board members to establish effective board policies, making policy decisions only after full discussion at publicly held meetings;
- 4. Delegate authority for the administration of The Academy to the administrator;
- 5. Encourage the free expression of opinion by all board members; engaging in deliberations that are germane to the topic, civil and personal;
- 6. Communicate to other board members and the Administrator expressions of public reaction to board policies and school programs;
- 7. Refrain from communications that may create conditions of bias should a school concern ever rise to the attention of the board as a hearings panel;
- 8. Inform myself about current educational issues by individual study and through participation in programs providing needed information, such as training sessions sponsored by state and national school board associations;
- 9. Support the employment of those best qualified to serve as school staff, and insist on regular and impartial evaluation of all staff;
- 10. Avoid being placed in a position of conflict of interest, and refrain from using my board position for personal or partisan gain;
- 11. Take no individual action that will compromise the board or administration, and respect the confidentiality of information that is privileged under applicable law; and
- 12. Remember always that my first and greatest concern must be the educational welfare of the students attending The Academy.
