## Curriculum guide discussion and feedback

- There hasn't been a curriculum guide since 2017-2018.
- A leadership team was put together so staff could collaborate building wide. The team includes staff from each department and 1 classified staff member so lots of voices could provide input on the curriculum guide.
- The goal is to have a guide showing everything offered so that parents and students know what's available.
- The team looked at what other schools were using and then used them as a guide to create the guide for OJSH which is now in version 2. Revisions are still underway with input from staff, then it will go out to students and be posted on the website. This will drive what classes are offered. Forecasting will be done, then the final schedule will come out. Everything is dependent on funding and staffing.
- Historically students have picked classes at the beginning of the year, but now they'll be able to leave in June knowing what their classes will be the next year.
- There will be a Zoom meeting for families in February or March to talk about the guide.
- Students will get the guide in advisory, track their progress and look at their grades, then choose what they want and need.

#### **Discussion of clubs**

- There are 6 JH clubs and going over well with students.
- Future plan is to have 1-2 times per month and ask the JH advisory group which clubs they should keep.
