Thank you for your patience with communication on the latest COVID19 updates. Thank you for all of your emails to the board and admin with your thoughts on the TRO decision from Friday.

On Friday, a judge in the circuit court in Sangamon County ruled in favor of the parents, students, teachers against the mask, vaccine and close contact mandates. Her decision affects those who sued and not the entire state, just the districts named and the Governor.

Gov. Pritzker is already filing an appeal. Mr. Devore will respond and the Appellate Court will hopefully clarify for all Illinois school districts.

After meeting with our state organization and our attorneys this morning, I have recommended some changes to the board of education, our union and staff. The changes are highlighted in yellow on the 21-22 In Person Learning Plan. I would like to express on behalf of the board of education that we were in favor of optional masks in August, but the liability was just too great to take that risk. With this recent ruling (even though we are not required to follow), the board and admin understand the risk is a little less in regards to liability and sanctions by the state. Although I am still concerned about student and staff health and safety, we all agree masking should be optional at this time. Please keep in mind this is **temporary** based on the recent TRO ruling. If the Appellate Court issues something different, that applies to the entire state, we may have to go back to mandatory masking.

Also - masking on the buses is MANDATORY. This court ruling in Sangamon County does not overrule

the Federal Mandate of masking on all transportation. Bus riders and drivers will be required to continue to mask. You may also drive your students to school. If you choose to drive your student, please be considerate and let your bus driver know so they can plan accordingly. If your child will continue to ride the bus, please make sure they have a mask for the morning, afternoon and all MJH shuttle routes.

I am including all of the resources here. The TRO ruling, the Executive Orders that were renewed on Friday and the updates to ISBE's FAQ and our In Person Learning Plan with the highlighted temporary suspensions.

Mrs. Rowe and I would also like to express that there will be consequences for any behaviors from students who make fun of students choosing to wear or not wear a mask. We will not tolerate any bullying or making fun of others due to this mask choice. We also want to express that all other mitigation measures outlined in the plan remain in place. Please continue to symptom check in Teacherease and please, please keep your student at home if they are sick. We will continue to offer testing on site if you choose. If your student has symptoms at school, they will be sent home.

Dear Newark CCSD 66 Parents and Guardians,

Beginning **January 11**, students and teachers across Illinois will have an opportunity to participate in the ninth annual statewide Illinois 5Essentials Survey. This survey is designed to generate a detailed picture of the inner workings of your child's school. As a parent, this opportunity will allow you to share your thoughts on the important elements of school effectiveness in a survey about your child's school.

On behalf of the Illinois State Board of Education, the Illinois 5Essentials Survey will be administered online by UChicago Impact at the University of Chicago. The survey gathers data related to five indicators that can predict important student outcomes, including improved attendance and larger test score gains. These five indicators that affect and predict school success are:

- · Effective Leaders
- Collaborative Teachers
- Involved Families
- · Supportive Environments
- · Ambitious Instruction

Prior research in more than 400 schools has shown that schools that were strong on at least three of these "5Essential" indicators were 10 times more likely to improve student learning gains in math and reading than those that were weak on three or more Essentials.

All teachers and **4th**th **through 12**th **grade students** will be responding to this survey. 5Essentials Reports will be generated for schools if their teachers and/or students meet the response rate threshold of 50 percent. These reports will be sent to schools and districts in April 2022 and will also be included in the State School Report Card.

Additionally, your district has chosen to provide the optional Parent Supplement survey. If at least 20 percent of Newark Grade School and Millbrook Jr. High parents complete this survey, a parent supplement report will also be generated. The parent data will not be reported on the State Report Card.

Your participation in the parent portion of the survey will help us understand the conditions at your child's school and guide improvement. Your identity and survey responses will be kept completely confidential and will never be connected to you or your child.

The Illinois 5Essentials Survey for students and teachers will be conducted January 11, 2022 through March 11, 2022. The Parent Survey Supplement will be conducted during that same timeframe.
