How can you help implement PBIS as a parent?

- Learn about our school expectations. **RES Behavior Expectations**
- Ask your child if he/she has received any PBIS points at the end of each day & talk to your child about what they did to earn points for
- Praise your child when he/she receives PBIS points
- Ask your child about how their day went. Ask questions such as: **What were you most proud of? What did you achieve? Were there any challenges? If so, how did you react? What additional support do you need from me [the parent] or the school?**
