Mrs. Boynton has continued to provide higher order thinking activities for our class and they have really shown amazing mathematical thinking!

- 8.6 Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Report working on draft annual update more at February meeting
- 8.7 2021-2022 Budget Report Denise Grinsell reported that she is already working on the 2nd Interim Report and will receive updated revenues from HCOE soon. Governor's proposed budget for 2022-23 has been released and some of the highlights as they apply to schools include:
 - \$16.1 billion in new revenues for k-14 Education but may be required to spend down reserves and a sizeable share of new funding for restricted purposes
 - 5.33% COLA for both base grant which increased revenues for ADA
 - 5.33% COLA to be applied to SPED, Child Nutrition, Mandated Block Grant among other programs.
 - COLA will not be applied to CTE, AIG, SWF
 - Because of state wide COVID related declining enrollment, he is proposing ADA be calculated by the greater of current year or prior year, and now the average of the three prior years. Analysts are unsure if this will actually help LEA's
 - IS continues to be sole alternative to in-person instruction for 22-23.
 - o All LEAs are required to offer IS in 22-23
 - o Allows synchronous instruction to count for instructional time
 - o Provide flexibilities for timeline to collect a signed IS agreement
 - Continued expansion of TK
 - \$1.3 billion for one-time School Facilities in 2022-23
 - Other notable changes include layoff process for classified personnel. The timeline is now the same as certificated personnel requiring decisions to be made now rather than in June.
 - Teacher and substitute shortages
 - No relief for STRS or PERS increases
 - Minimum wage increases

- 8.8 Elementary School Principal Report Principal Landry handed out a copy of our COVID situation, trends in dealing with absences of both staff and students. Things are definitely improving. He was proud of staff that has really stepped up to cover others and we are doing much better than many other districts.
- 8.9 High School Principal/Superintendent Report Supt. Anderson students did very well at FFA speaking contest. Girls basketball is ranked 1st in league and in the county against bigger schools. Games are live streamed. End of 1st semester last week with 20 students out so still finishing finals. Grades will be delayed one to two weeks. Went over spectators and athletics changes. Now at 4 people per family and must be masked. Spring sports start February 7. Working on WASC report with virtual one-day site visit in May. Beginning college acceptance season. Working on LCAP annual update with things constantly changing. Thank you to Jodi McDonald, Sharon Richardson, and Mr. Landry for all testing. California is looking at enrollment based funding rather than attendance based. New learning loss mitigation funding for required extended school days and school years. We would need to address infrastructure issues first for staffing and space. Also a universal TK rollout is coming soon. Next year, high school start time will be 8:30 a.m. but should not be a big deal. Keeping an eye on vaccine mandate legislation.
