

Curriculum Development

The curricula of the Jemez Valley Schools shall be consistent with the board's adopted instructional goals and the Standard for Excellence adopted by the Public Education Department. The District shall implement an academic plan aimed at improving achievement for all students with an intense focus on closing any achievement gap. Subject matter shall be developed and modified by the district professional staff at appropriate levels to meet changing district instructional goals and state requirements.
