#### **Administration**

- **COVID-19** (**Coronavirus**): Due to health and safety precautions, Las Cruces Public Schools will be implementing comprehensive safety guidelines. - **Preschool Openings:** Families are able to apply for Head Start and/or New Mexico PreK online. Applications are also taken over the phone by early childhood professionals who are able to assist both our English and Spanish-Speaking families. - **Professional Development Opportunities:** Teachers, educational assistants, and administrators have received multiple opportunities to participate in trainings and workshops throughout the Fall semester.
- **Practice-Based Coaching:** Preschool teachers are participating in Practice Based Coaching (PBC). PBC is a cyclical process for supporting teachers' implementation of evidence-based teaching practices in the areas of literacy, social emotional learning, and multi-lingual WIDA principles that lead to positive learning outcomes for our district's youngest children. Teachers and coaches work together in developing short-term goals and action planning, focused observations, reflection, and feedback throughout the instructional year. Four Early Childhood Instructional Coaches (ECICs) deliver coaching in collaboration from LCPS NM PreK, LCPS Head Start and our partners at Central Region Educational Cooperative (CREC).
