Dear Parent(s) and/or Guardian(s):

We hope this letter finds you and your family enjoying a safe and relaxing summer. As hard as it may be to believe, the 2018-2019 school year is just around the corner. The first day of school for the upcoming school year for K-12 students is Tuesday, September 4, 2018. Junior Kindergarten students begin on Thursday, September 6, 2018. The Northview Sneak Peek is Wednesday, August 29, 4:30 p.m.-6:00 p.m.

The first step in preparing for the upcoming school year is the registration process. Each family in the district received a mailing detailing the online registration process. The registration window will be open July 24-30, 2018. All registration tasks will be done through Skyward, which is our student management system. Please go to our website <http://www.hgtigers.org> and choose the following path: MENU, 2018-2019 REGISTRATION, CLICK HERE TO BEGIN. This will take you to the login page of our Skyward Student Management System. If you do not have access to a computer, there will be one available for your use at the Northview office, on the dates listed below. The purpose of this mailing is to provide a building specific registration listing of fees. All other forms are online under the Forms tab.

Listed below are the fees associated with your child(ren)'s attendance at Northview:

Registration Fee per student \$40.00
Milk Break @\$20.00 a semester or \$40.00 a year per student (optional)

Pictures will take place at Northview on the following dates and times:

Wednesday, July 25

9:00 am – 2:00 pm & 3:00 – 6:00 pm

Monday, July 30

8:00 am – 1:00 pm & 2:00 – 5:00 pm

Northview student picture retake day will be September 14.

The Northview office will be CLOSED on Friday, July 27.

The cost of student lunches at Northview are \$2.50/daily and \$12.50 (weekly). Families will again use a lunch account envelope/deposit form for deposits to accounts. A form for deposit to the account can be found on the website. Students will use their Student ID Swipe Card for purchases. If your child purchases a milk to go with their cold lunch, this will also come from the family lunch account balance.

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Parents may sign up for their student's Fall Parent Teacher Conferences on Picture Days or at Sneak Peek on Wednesday, August 29, 4:30-6:00 p.m. Sign-up sheets will be in the front lobby.

School Board Policy 6152 provides an opportunity for a fee waiver should a family demonstrate an inability to pay the fees. The main criteria to determine qualification for a fee waiver will be eligibility for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program. **If you wish to explore the fee waiver option before registration, you must complete the application form, along with the Free & Reduced Lunch Application, if applicable, located on the district website and submit it to the District Office for processing. Free and Reduced Lunch status is separate from Fee Waiver. Free and Reduced Lunch status is only one of several criteria used to determine the appropriateness of a Fee Waiver.** Those who are eligible for Free and Reduced Lunch **may** receive a waiver. If your family situation should change during the course of the school year, any potential fee waiver will be dealt with following a similar procedure. It is important to note that any fee that has been paid will not be reimbursed if a family should qualify for Free and Reduced Lunch after fees have been paid. Please contact the district office if you have any questions about the fee waiver.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation in helping to make the 2018-2019 registration a positive and efficient event for everyone involved. Please feel free to contact the Northview office if you have any questions.
