## DODGEBALL TOURNAMENT

Friday, March 18

### The Breakdown:

A team consists of 6 players but can have 3 additional players on the roster. We reserve the right to disqualify any team for inappropriate sportsmanship or conduct. All jewelry must be removed prior to the start of the match. A team may have additional players on the roster, but no substitutions can occur once the game has started and all players must be listed on the official roster handed in prior to the tournament.

### Winning the GAME!

Game play duration is best two out of three 4 minute periods. Three dodgeballs will start with each team. The game is over when all of one team's players are eliminated, or if when time elapses the team with the most players left wins. During the last minute of each match the court perimeter will be reduced to the volleyball lines. If, after time has expired, there is a tie, then there will be a 2 minute sudden-death period between the remaining players where the first team to have a player eliminated loses. Make sure your team is around just in case the games get over early.

### Hits and Outs:

- You are OUT if: You get hit anywhere by the ball or an opponent catches your throw.
- You step over the center line with both feet.
- You can use the ball for defense but if the oncoming ball bounces off and hits you, you're OUT.
- The ball is LIVE until it hits the floor. So, if the ball hits you AND a teammate, you BOTH are OUT.

Please practice good sportsmanship and refrain from arguing with the officials.

### Does it count?

If the ball hits the floor OR wall it's a DEAD ball. Head shots do count.

### Team Building:

When a teammate catches a ball, one of the "out players" (for that team) can re-enter the game in order of elimination.

Age Requirements: All contestants must be 8<sup>th</sup> grade or older. All teams will be in the same bracket.

# BHS DODGEBALL

## TOURNAMENT RULES



1. Matches will be decided best 2 out of 3.
2. Games will be 4 min in length.
3. The team with more players at the end of the 4 min wins.
4. If tied at the end of 4 min, sudden death will begin, and the next person out loses.
5. To begin each game teams will have equal number of balls.
6. A player is deemed out if they are hit anywhere with the ball, but may block with the ball.
7. A ball that hits the floor, ceiling, hoop, wall, or out player is no longer live.
8. A deflection off a teammate that is caught saves the person hit, and the thrower is out.
9. A deflection that hits two players but is not caught results in both players being out.
10. There will be a "floating off sides" (a player is not out unless they cross the middle line entirely with both feet)
11. If a player catches a ball, a teammate returns to play in the order of getting out. The thrower is out.
12. If all balls are on one side of the court for more than 20 seconds they will be divided up evenly.
13. Subbing can only occur between games, not during.
14. The back boundary will be the volleyball line extended. If a player steps across the backline with both feet they are out.
15. Each team needs retrievers to retrieve dodgeballs behind the back boundary.
