CHILD FIND NOTICE

In accordance with IDEA regulations, the Thomasville City Schools seek to ensure that all disabled students (ages 3-21) who are in need of special education within its jurisdiction are identified, located, and evaluated, including those attending private school and home school.

If the "child find" process indicates that a student may require special education and supportive services in order to benefit from regular education, the student shall be referred to the Placement Team. Final identification of students with disabilities and programming for such students occurs only after an appropriate evaluation and a determination by a Placement Team that the student is meets eligibility criteria for special education services.

A consultation regarding participation in child find services and discussion of how proportionate share funds will be used during the 2022-2023 school year is scheduled for 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 7, 2022.
