Scholarship Criteria:

- This scholarship\mentoring program will target graduating high school seniors
 - The student must be in good academic standing.
 - Must have a minimum **GPA 3.2 or higher on a 4.0 scale**; therefore, please submit your high school transcript with this application.
 - Pursue a bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college
 - Be highly motivated and available for extra-curricular opportunities, able to meet physical requirements, and capable of adjusting to being away from home.
 - Completion of scholarship application package
 - Provide documented **acceptance notice** from a four year college or university.
 - A one or two page **biographical sketch** including information on the applicant's background, personal philosophy, and career goals.
 - One wallet size **photo** (senior class photo may be used).
 - A total of **two** letters of **reference**- one from each of the following: your teacher, counselor, and community/religious leader.
 - Completed application and all supporting documentation must be submitted by **March 27, 2023** to your Guidance Department by 12 noon.
