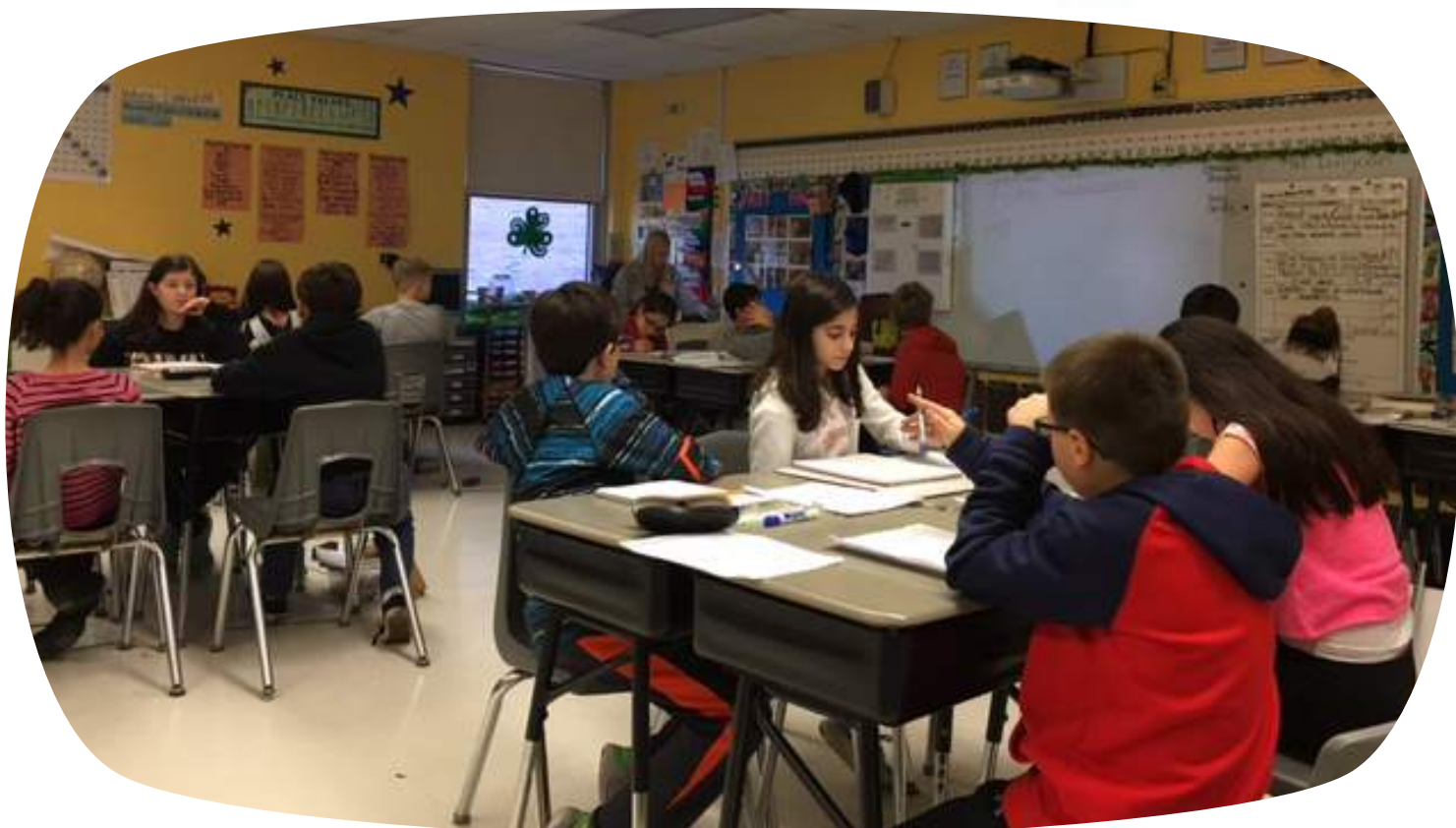

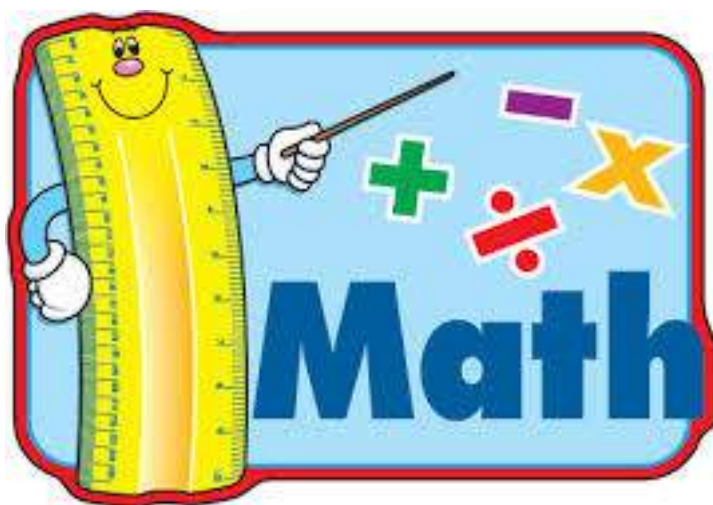

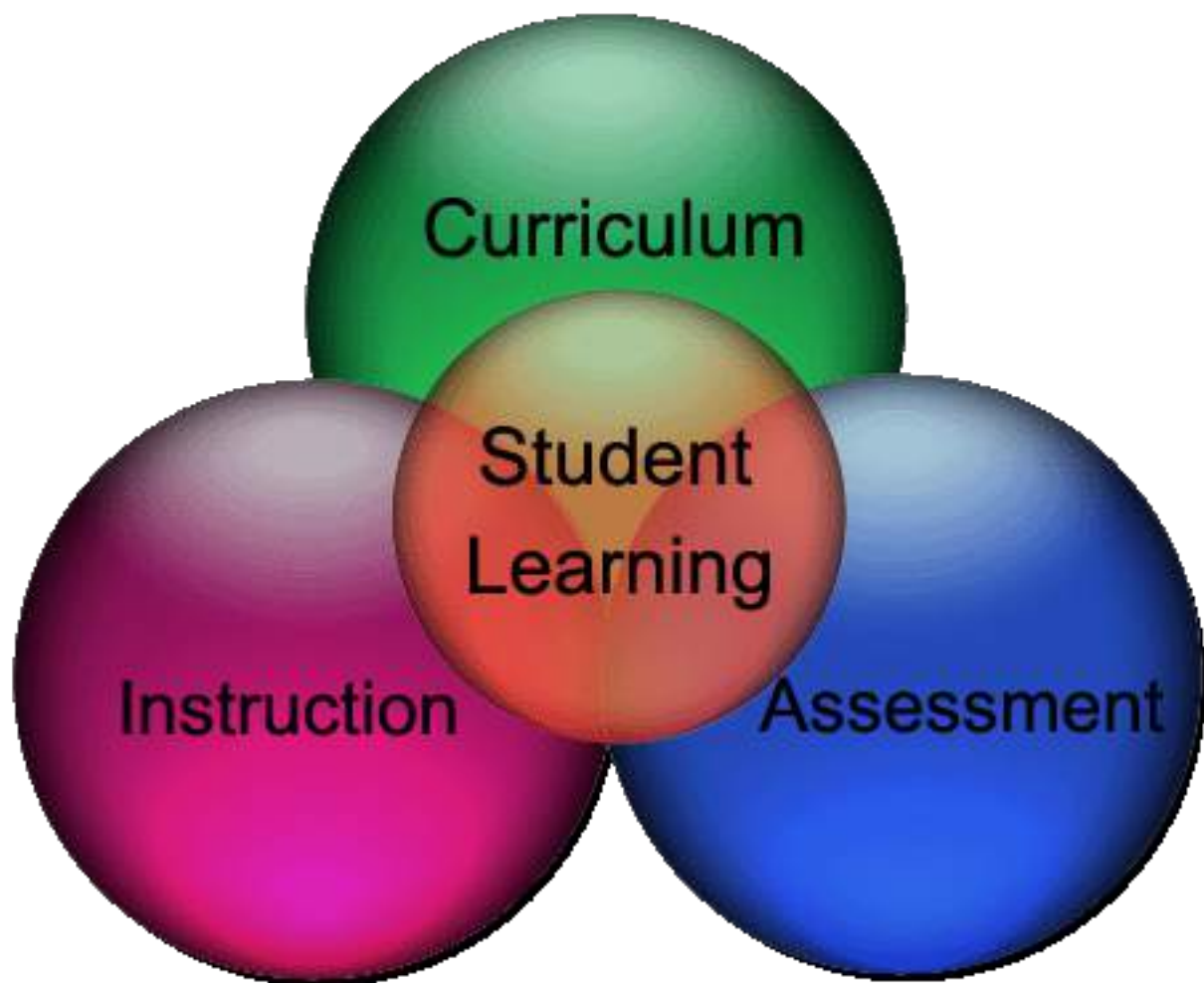
FOOD DRIVE
