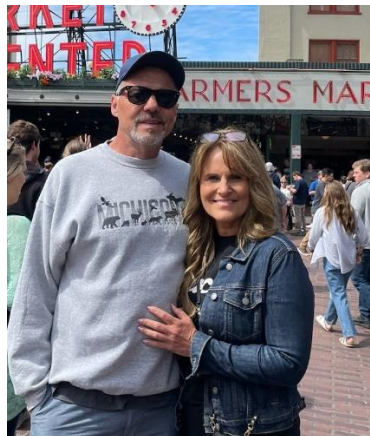
Drama Club Talent Show
