Staff will be determining which students need to take exams. Students who are exempt from taking an exam can take the exam to improve their score without having to worry about their final grade dropping. Below are the criteria students must meet to be exempt from exams:

1. Has three (3) or fewer unexcused absences during the semester. Funeral, medical, and court absences do not count against the attendance incentive. All excuses must be turned into the office within one week from the day the student returns to school.
2. Has improved PSAT/SAT Composite Score or scored proficient since the last screening.
3. Has no In-House or Out-of-School Suspensions.
4. Has not been tardy more than two (2) times in the affected class.
5. Has attained a B- or better both marking periods.
