The Staff Spotlight for the week of February 27, 2023 is Mr. Stange. Mr Stange graduated from Millington High School in 2010. Both of Mr. Stange's parents and his brother, Kyle, attended MHS. Throughout his high school career, he was involved in the Industrial Arts Program, where he won first place in the MITES Competition in the Plastics Division. Mr. Stange also participated in fundraising activities such as the Dodgeball and Ping Pong Tournaments. Mr. Stange went on to earn his Bachelors of Arts Degree in Secondary Education and is certified to teach English and History. This is Mr. Stange's sixth year working at Millington Community Schools; he started out as a full-time substitute teacher before becoming a full-time teacher. Since he has been teaching, he
