- Unland We received a dividend check of \$347.34 due to the group's performance.
- Gym Project Update bleacher contractor was here today to repair some of our seats – most issues were with the recessed handicap seating. H2I is giving us two new backboards at no charge to address the shaking on the north end. That installation is expected to take place on December 28th – backboards have already arrived.

- SHIELD Testing Ken, Stefanie, and I attended a ZOOM meeting to discuss potential school-wide testing with SHIELD. This test is the saliva test that was invented by the University of Illinois. For a school of our size, it had some challenges:
 - 3 6 week start up delay/time frame
 - Weekly testing
 - o 18 hour turn around time
 - Would need to drive samples to Galesburg (closest location currently)
 - Would need consent from families focus would be to catch nonsymptomatic positives.

- \$300 start-up costs, but we would then be paid \$8 per test. Transportation would be at district expense.
- o If we are not interested in weekly testing, then SHIELD is not for us.
- o Midwest Coordination Center (Another option) minimum of 5 tests
- Congratulations to our 7th and 8th grade girls basketball teams on their excellent seasons. Both teams lost in the championship of their respective regionals.
- Special thanks to Ms. Kunkel for all of her efforts to host our K-4 Christmas Program. Thank you as well to our staff and our parents for their understanding and flexibility.
- 5th/6th Grade Basketball numbers are very low. We are going to allow 4th graders to practice only.
- Finally, General Assembly (legislature) plans to be in session starting January 4th (both houses). With a June primary, they want to be completed by the end of April.
