Greetings District 161 students, families, and staff,

This is an exciting week in District 161! Congratulations to the 8th Grade Boys Basketball Team for winning Sectionals and advancing to the state tournament this weekend. We will be there to cheer them on to victory and I know they will represent their families and their school very well. Also, our COVID-19 numbers continue to remain low, our quarantines are decreasing, and there appears to be a light at the end of this tunnel. At Monday's Board of Education meeting, we will be discussing the next steps in our COVID-19 mitigation efforts, which include plans to stop quarantines for "close contacts" and to go mask optional on March 14th if our numbers continue to stay low. I am thankful for everyone who has reached out to me with feedback on this topic and I believe that our plans are reflective of the District 161 community's input.

#### **COVID-19 Metrics**

As of today, we have 6 active COVID-19 cases between students and staff members in our 5 schools and district office. In addition, we have 0 outbreaks at this time.
