Dear Families,

The past week was filled with both reasons to be grateful and reasons for reflection. I feel it is important to take a moment to do both.

First, in light of Memorial Day yesterday, I would like to take a moment to reflect on the sacrifices made by the brave men and women who have lost their lives protecting our country. We are forever indebted to these heros for their bravery and their fearless commitment to the American ideals of democracy, freedom, liberty, equality, justice, and opportunity. We hold them in our hearts, with gratitude, forever.

In light of the tragedy in Texas, we must pause to process the depth of the Uvalde community's grief and the grief of our entire country, while simultaneously considering how we can ensure the safety of our own students.

As you know, we have a caring, dedicated staff whose first priority is student safety. Please be assured that Manchester Elementary is committed to the safety of every student, and regularly reviews our Safety Plan to ensure all contingencies are considered. We will continue to practice safety measures and we continuously seek to improve procedures. If you have questions,

As your family processes this recent tragedy, we would recommend keeping the conversation about the details to a minimum, while allowing your child's questions to guide you. Finally, we thank you for putting your trust in us. Sending us your child each day is a vote of confidence that we take very seriously. We look forward to continuing to work together with our community to ensure our students are safe at school.
