It is resolved that the Board, through Mitchell Technical Institute, will provide 20% of the funds for a non-motorized pathway on and near the MTI campus should MTI receive sufficient grant funding for the project. The dollar amount to be paid by the District will be \$97,200 if phase I and II of the project are funded for the fully requested grant amount of \$486,000. Phase III will be implemented at some future date. Amounts less that this will result in a lower district cost and will be allowed as long as there are enough funds to create a useful part of the pathway project.
