New Activities Director




Mr. Blake Beebout was named the new Activities Director/Assistant Principal for Valentine Community Schools. The position became available after Gus Brown moved on to another district.




Enrollment





Valentine Community Schools was the recipient of an AWARE Grant. AWARE stand for Advancing Wellness and Resilience in Education.


Funds from the AWARE grant allow Valentine Community Schools to focus on mental and

State Testing


